

GETTING ON


Getting on to the hoverboard may be tricky at first. Below are included tips and tricks on how to get onto the hoverboard safely. The assistance of a second person may be required to help assist the user's balance.

- 1. Do not turn the hoverboard on immediately. First, get comfort able standing on the platform first keeping your feet flat.
- 2. It is best to step onto the hoverboard quickly and without hesi tation as if walking up stairs. If uncomfortable, use the assistance of a second person to safely step onto the board.
- 3. When turning on the hoverboard, keep in mind the sensors are sensitive to all movement.



RIDING THE HOVERBOARD

- 1. Press the power button to turn on the hover board
- 2. Step onto the hoverboard platform:
- To move forward, slightly lean your body forward
- To reverse, slightly lean your body backwards.
- To turn, look where you want to go before shifting your body and the board will follow.
- 3 If you need to go over bumps or rough surfaces, slightly bend your knees to absorb some of the impact.
- 4. To get off the hoverboard, step off the platform one foot at a time.



CHARGING

- 1. Using the included cable, plug one end into the hoverboard and the plug into a suitable wall outlet.
- 2. Make sure the charging port is dry when connecting the charging cable.
- 3. It will approximately take up to 5 hours for the hoverboard to be completely charged.
