Combatting Calluses

Professional Treatment Protocol

ITEMS YOU WILL NEED:

- 4x4 Gauze Pad
- Water
- botana-gel cleanser™
- glycolic acid 30%
- treatment neutralizer
- microdermabrasion system
- retinyl enzyme treatment
- argan boost serum™
- daily eclipse™ oil free sunscreen SPF 30



Offer your customers a pedicure add-on treatment that will deliver immediate results. By combining microdermabrasion and a chemical peel, this protocol will reveal soft and smooth skin with long-term benefits.

PROCEDURE:

1. Cleansing

- Apply botana-gel cleanser™ with green tea to the feet.
- Massage gently to cleanse.
- Rinse with water and pat dry.

2. glycolic acid 30%

- Put glycolic acid 30% on a 4"-by- 4" gauze pad.
- Carefully apply to the heel and callused areas, which is typically the heel and ball of the foot and the pads of the toes, keeping clear of bunions.
- Leave on for 3 to 4 minutes.

3. Neutralize

- Saturate a 4"-by- 4" gauze pad with treatment neutralizer.
- Generously apply to the feet.
- Rinse with water and pat dry.
- 4. Microdermabrasion Procedure (this may be performed with an aggressive tip, such as the MegaPeel gold hand-piece and tip).
 - Dry the feet thoroughly prior to treatment.
 - Make 2 passes over the callused areas. Treat each area vertically the first time, horizontally the second time.
 - Slowly glide the hand-piece over the skin back and forth over the area.
 - Dust any particles off the skin.

5. retinyl enzyme treatment

- Apply a thin layer of retinyl enzyme to a 4"-by- 4" gauze pad.
- Wipe the product over the feet.
- Leave on for 5 minutes.
- Use a clean, wet 4"-by- 4" gauze pad to remove.
- Pinse
- Repeat until the skin is no longer sticky. (Do this at least 2 times.)

6. argan boost serum™

- Apply argan boost serum[™] generously to the feet.
- Gently massage the feet.
- Place a hot towel over the feet or do a paraffin treatment and leave on for at least 10 minutes.

7. Finish

 Apply daily eclipse[™] - oil free sunscreen barrier protection to the top of the feet if they will be exposed to sunlight.

CONTRAINDICATIONS:

- Accutane use within one or two years (assessment made by physician)
- Fitzpatrick skin types IV VI (may create hyper-pigmentation)
- Pregnancy or lactation
- Anyone with an infectious disease
- Open sores, suspicious lesions, or basal cell carcinoma (Always refer to a physician)

AFTER CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Instruct patient to use the following treatment at home on the feet:

- AHA salicylic solution. Remove excess with warm wash cloth.
- Apply argan boost serum[™].
- Follow with a layer of green tea vita-E moisturizer™.
- Place socks on feet.

FOLLOW-UP TREATMENTS

Patient should follow up with treatments at 3-4 week intervals.
