













- Cut two pieces of paper to same height & width.
 Recommend height extend at least 1" above top of vessel.
 Width of paper = circumference of vessel.
- 2. Draw/trace silhouette line on the back of one sheet.
- 3. Stack paper together with patterned sides facing. Gently bend both sheets so left & right edges meet. Make sure not to crease paper.
- Cut vase silhouette line.
 Hold paper together with clips or paperclips to make it easier to cut.
- 5. Flip paper so patterned sides are now facing out.
- 6. Glue edges together with a permanent glue stick. Highly recommend, and use myself, the Scotch Create permanent glue stick. Allow glue to dry completely before putting paper vase over vessel.
- 7. Trim edges if white side of paper is showing.
