POTENTIAL HEALTH EFFECTS:

Eye:

Contact may cause mild, transient irritation. Some redness and/or stinging may occur.



Skin:

SECTION 4 - FIRST AID MEASURES

Eye: Thorough rinsing for 15-20 minutes of the affected eye with water is recommended. If discomfort or irritation persists, consult a physician.

Precautions for Safe Handling:

For Household Settings: Do not expose to heat and flame. Use only in ventilated areas. Contents under pressure. Do not puncture or incinerate container or store it at temperatures above 120°F (~50°C). Keep out of reach of children.

For Non-Household Settings: Avoid heat, sparks, flame, or smoking during use. Do not crush, puncture or incinerate. Avoid extreme heat and ignition sources. Avoid spraying toward open flame. Avoid puncturing or otherwise damaging aerosol containers and packaging when using forklifts or other material handling equipment.

Conditions for Safe Storage:

For Household Settings: Pressurized container. Protect from sunlight and do not expose to temperatures exceeding 120°F .. 50 DERECE keep from extreme cold.

For Non-Household Settings: Pressurized container. Protect from sunlight and do not expose to temperatures exceeding 120°F (~50°C). Keep from extreme cold. Store in accordance with local requirements for Aerosol Level 2. Store away from oxidizers. Store in a well ventilated, cool area.
