IMPACT REPORT - JAN 2022

BACKGROUND

Project: Kids, Let's Be Superheroes is an age-appropriate, medically vetted storybook for children (aged 6-12) and caregivers that helps facilitate conversations around the mental health impact of COVID on children. The book addresses caregiver's concerns about changes in a child's behaviour, promotes active discussion and provides coping strategies for caregivers to implement with their children.

OBJECTIVE

In partnership with the Bell Let's Talk Community fund, print versions of Project: Kids, Let's Be Superheroes were donated to various frontline organizations around Eastern Ontario in need of mental health resources. The goal of this campaign was to have individuals engage in conversations around mental wellness through the use of the storybook - Project: Kid's Let's Be Superheroes.
