



LIVE EDGE EPOXY DESK INSTRUCTIONS

Live-edge epoxy desks are one of the most desirable pieces of furniture available today that are being adorned in stylish office spaces. Here are the instructions to put your desk together.



INSTRUCTIONS

01

DESK FRAME INSTALLATION

Follow desk frame installation instructions and complete building the desk frame.

02

TURN DESK TOP UPSIDE DOWN

Place epoxy desk top on blanket or carpet upside down.

03

PLACE FRAME ON TOP

Place frame on top of the desk and line up holes to the edges (*middle ones may not be aligned so ignore those*).

04

SCREWS FOR FRAME & HANDSET

Use the pointed screws **ST4X16** for the desk frame and **ST4X20** for the handset.

DESK FRAME SCREWS:

Ignore holes with the epoxy design. Each design varies but will likely have 7 out of 11 holes showing wood.

HANDSET SCREWS:

Select a side (right or left) to install the handset and screw it into the opposite (think about when you flip the desk).
To install the handset on the right side, drill it into the table on the left and vice versa.

After Care Instructions

Now that your desk is built, you'll want to keep it looking great for years to come. Here are a few important things to keep in mind when looking after your desk:

#1 HOT OBJECTS

You should not place hot objects directly on the desk (pots, pans, plates or mugs) as this may mark the surface. Instead, use coasters or heatproof mats.

#2 AVOID DIRECT SUNLIGHT

Wooden products with epoxy, like any other wood products, are recommended for indoor use only. If the desk is exposed to the sun for long it can damage the epoxy.

#3 DO NOT USE ABRASIVE MATERIALS

When cleaning the desk, make sure to only use a soft sponge or towel and do not use any scratchy steel pads or other abrasive material as it is not scratch-proof.

How to properly clean my desk?

Always start out using soap and water to wipe away most stains and spots on your epoxy desk. You can also use gentle spray cleaners, such as a glass cleaner, to get a shiny, streak-free, and spotlessly clean surface. If you notice that your table looks a bit dull, you can use mineral oil and buff it with a dry towel to make it shine again.

If you follow all the tips for care and maintenance, your table will retain its unique beauty and practicality.
