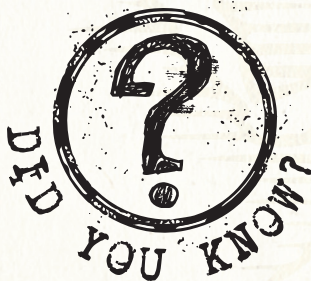
MISSION IMPOSSIBLE OR IS IT POSSIBLE?

(Discovering Jesus' Mission)

BEGIN THE JOURNEY:

Do you ever feel like there are tasks given to you or expectations placed on you that are simply IMPOSSIBLE? For example, I feel like it is IMPOSSIBLE for me to finish a 300-page book in one day.
