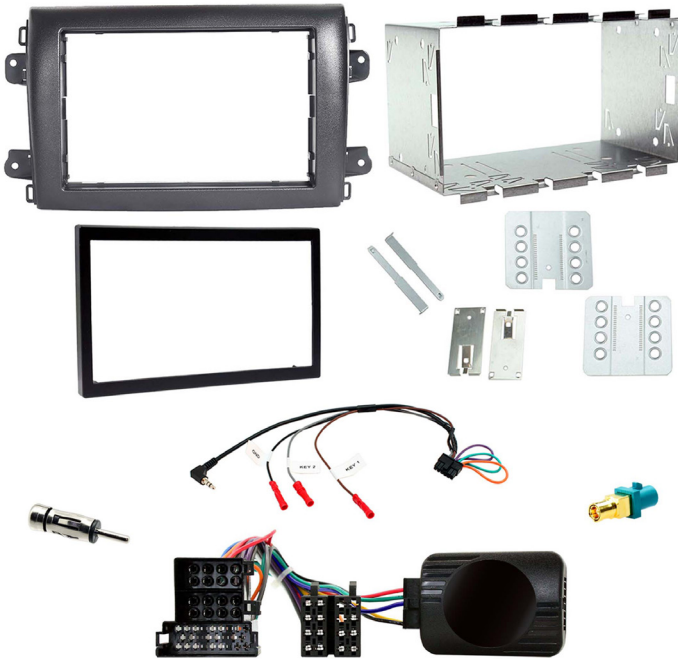
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ABOUT THIS PRODUCT

The **KW8FT29** installation kit allows for the retention of the vehicle's steering wheel controls and helps maintain the original aesthetic of the interior when installing a new car stereo. The **KW8FT29** gives you everything you need for a complete install in one box. The components of this kit are compatible for the Fiat Ducato (8 Series 2021-UP) with no factory stereos (open-dash vehicles). The wiring harness and interface will retain the steering wheel controls. The interface supplied features a Mini ISO connector.

NB: this installation kit is intended for vehicles which feature no factory radio as standard.

FITTING GUIDE

STEREO REMOVAL

1. Begin by using a panel removal tool to unclip the 2x pockets that sit within the main dash where the main head unit would normally be situated.
2. With the pockets removed, use the panel removal tool to undo the 2x fans that surround the main aperture and place them to one side.
3. Now that the air vents have been removed, you will then need to undo the 4x screws that surround the main fascia.

FASCIA PLATE SET-UP

1. Attach the brackets to the new stereo. These brackets allow you to set the specific depth of the unit in relation to the fascia plate. Start by lining up the spacers (**Fig 1.**) on the inside of the plates (**Fig 2.**).

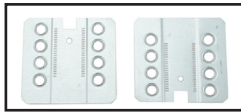

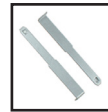

2. Attach the spacer and plate combination to the corresponding side of the stereo using the screws that come with the stereo. Test this set up outside of the dashboard by sliding into the radio cage.
3. Take the fascia in hand, and slide the caged radio combination through the opening. If the depth/alignment of the stereo hangs out too much/is recessed too far, use the radio removal keys (**Fig 3.**) to release the stereo from the cage and repeat the process.
4. Once configured correctly and the **“Stereo Installation”** process has been complete, slide the fascia/cage combination into the dashboard and screw into place using the pre-existing screws, then reassemble the dashboard to complete the installation.

FITTING GUIDE

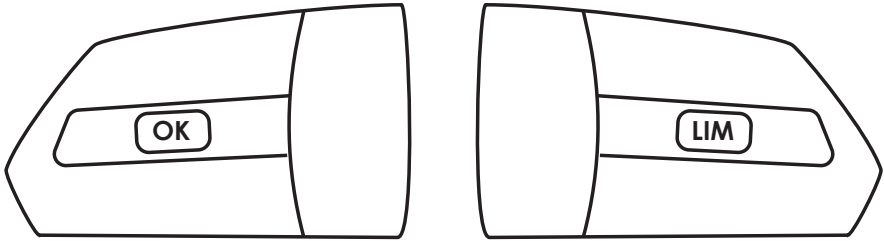
STEREO INSTALLATION

1. Take the steering wheel control interface and attach the 14-way steering wheel harness connector to the relevant side.
2. Make a cut within the purple loop on the back of the patch lead connector. Then proceed to attach '**Key 1**' to the light blue/yellow 'SWC Remote' wire on the stereo. When done, connect the 12-way connector to the steering wheel control interface.
3. Attach the vehicle specific FM antenna adapter to the vehicles pre-existing connection and into the back of the new stereo.
4. Attach the fakra DAB antenna adapter to the vehicles pre-existing connection and into the back of the new stereo.
5. When all the above wires (and any additional accessories) have been connected, finally make the power connections between the stereo and the vehicles pre-existing connector.

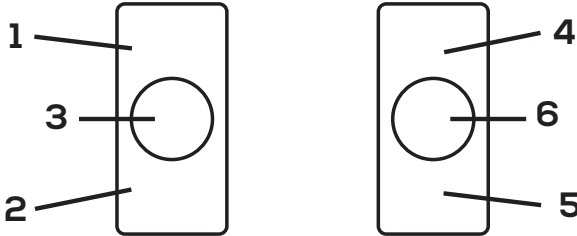
STEERING WHEEL CONTROL FUNCTIONALITY

Please note: steering wheel controls dealing with car menus and cruise control on the front are unaffected. Controls on front dealing with phone control are not retained.

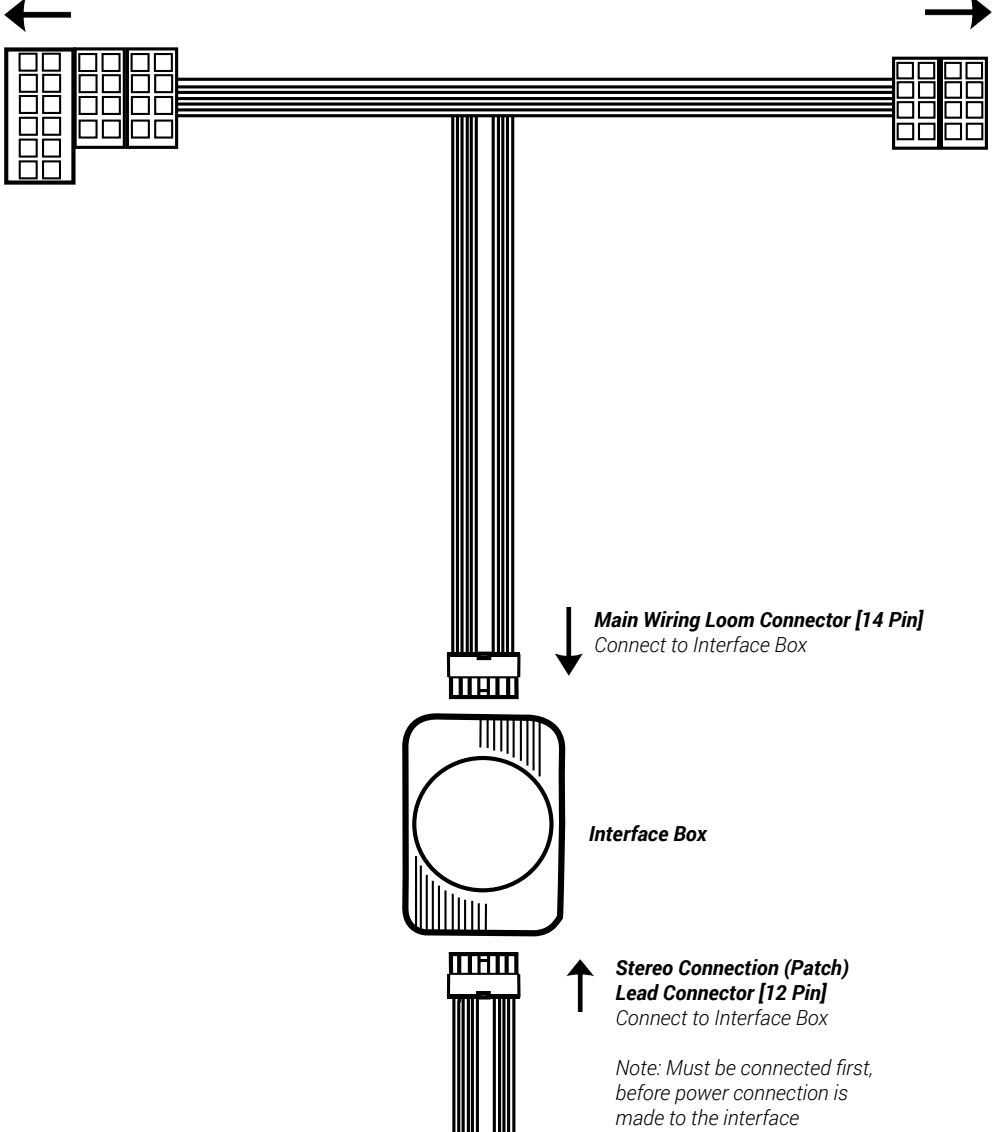
WIRING DIAGRAM
