Uncorked:

Liberty School Cabernet Sauvignon comes from the Hope family in Paso Robles California. In 1978 the Hope family took a chance on planting vineyards in Paso Robles and their chance paid off, for Paso Robles is now known for creating some fantastic value driven wines. The Liberty School Cabernet is a beautiful ruby-black color with nice fruit aromas of black currant, black cherry and fresh blackberry, with notes of violets and toasted oak. The palate is full and lush with plum and strawberry fruit flavors followed by hints of vanilla and allspice. The finish is long with supple tannins and just the right amount of juicy acidity. This wine is great with a variety of food pairings, my favorite being a juicy grilled rib-eye steak. Be sure to stop into the store on Friday, October 13th for our tasting to try this great wine and several others.
