Materials

1 set 6" double point needles, size 4 (5). Cascade Yarns Ultra Pima Fine, sport weight cotton or (Ultra Pima, DK) stitch marker to mark needle 1, tapestry needle

Outer Piece	# sts
CO 3 sts *	3sts
Next row - kfb every stitch	6sts
Divide on 3 needles - Start knitting in the round	6 - 2 each ndl
Round 1 - kfb, k1 each needle	9 - 3 each ndl
Rnd 2 - K to last st on each needle, m1, k1. place stitch marker	12 -4 each nd l
A cup - Repeat rnd 2 24(18) times or amount to equal 5" diameter (across)	84(66) - 28(22) each ndl
B cup - Repeat rnd 2 26(20) times or amount to equal 5.5" diameter (across)	90(72)- 30(24) each ndl
C cup - Repeat rnd 2 30(24) times or amount to equal 6" diameter (across)	102(84) - 34(28) each ndl
D cup - Repeat rnd 2 32(26) times or amount to equal 6.5" diameter (across)	108(90) - 36(30) each ndl
E cup - Repeat rnd 2 34(28) times or amount to equal 7" diameter (across)	114(96) - 38(32) each ndl
Purl 2 rounds	

Inner Piece

Round 1 - K to last 2 sts, k 2 tog (each needle)

Round 2 - Ssk, k to last 2 sts, k 2 tog (each needle)

Repeat Rnds 1 and 2 til 12 sts total (4 each needle)

Cut yarn (long tail) - thread tail through 12 sts and leave loose to allow for stuffing

Fill with Fiber Fil - (Optional, we will fill for you if you want :-))

*Optional nipple: work 4 rows of I-cord. Knot I-Cord very tightly and stitch down for small nipple Visit www.knittedknockers.org for tips and video on How to make great knitted knockers.
