VINIFICATION

MANUAL HARVEST IN 12 KG BOXES ON 24 SEPTEMBER 2015. FERMENTATION IN TRADITIONAL CLAY POTS (AMPHORA) FOR A PERIOD OF 12 DAYS. SKIN CONTACT UNTIL THE 11TH OF NOVEMBER.

AGING IN AMPHORA FOR 48 MONTHS THEREAFTER IN BOTTLE FOR 12 MONTHS

TASTING NOTES

DEEP RUBY COLOUR. NOSE OF GREAT COMPLEXITY WITH STRONG MINERAL CHARACTER AND SOME GREEN NOTES. LONG TASTE WITH REFRESHING ACIDITY AND GREAT BALANCE. FIRM AND POLISHED TANNINS IN A SET THAT WILL ALLOW A GREAT EVOLUTION IN THE BOTTLE.
