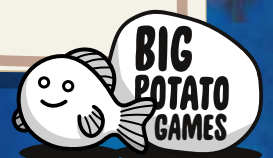




SOUNDS FISHY


One real answer. A sea of red herrings.

If you already own the original Sounds Fishy, then simply print out these cards (or read them on your phone) and dive straight in. If you're new to the game, then check out the rules below deck.



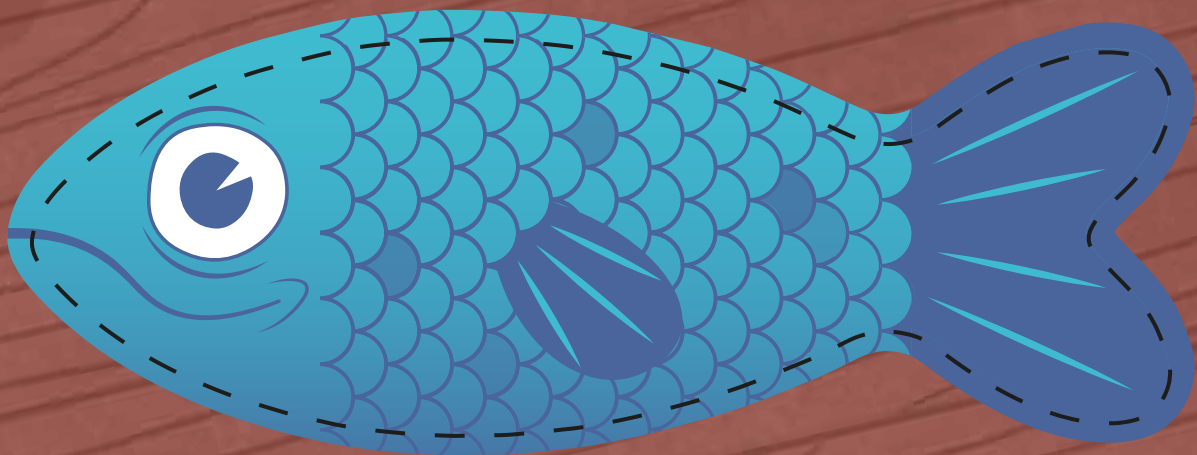


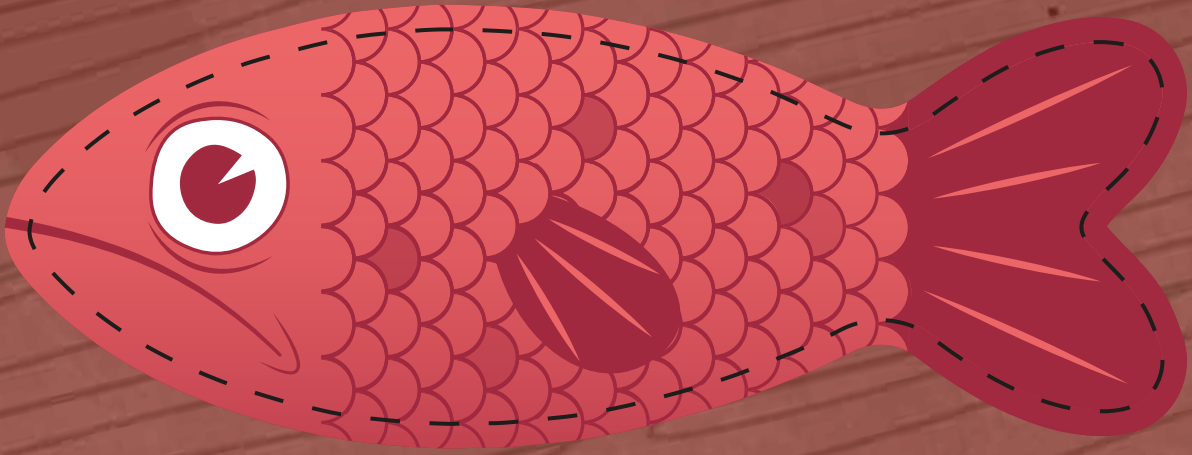
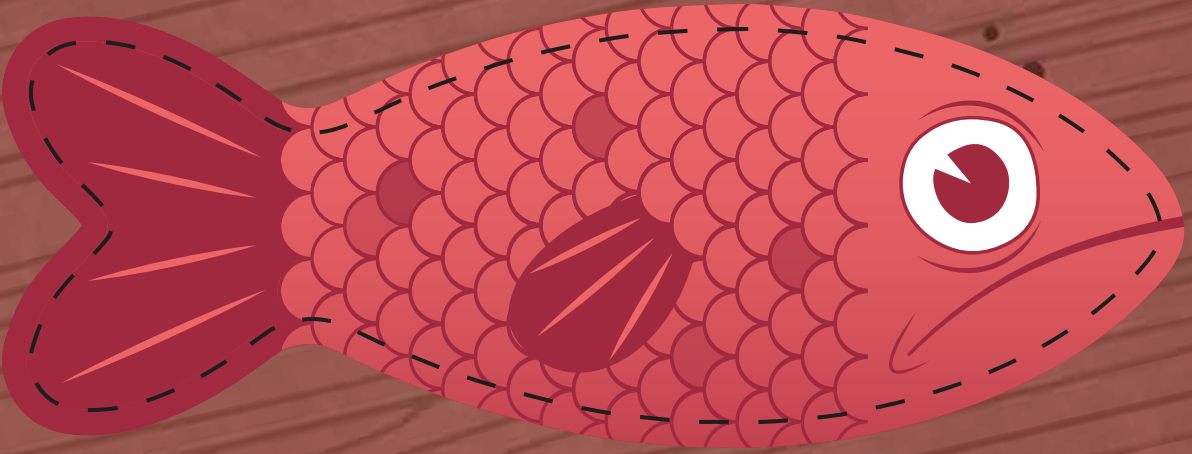
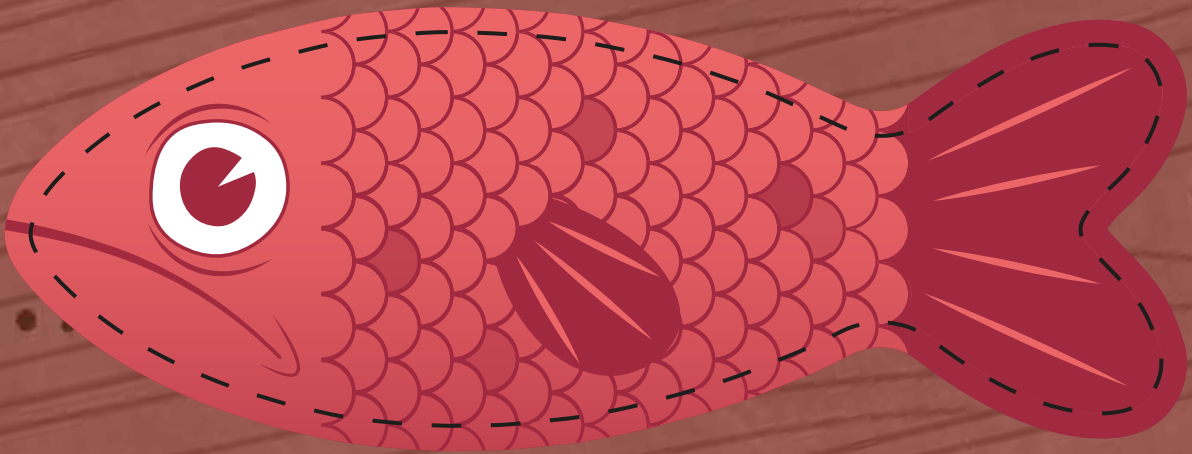
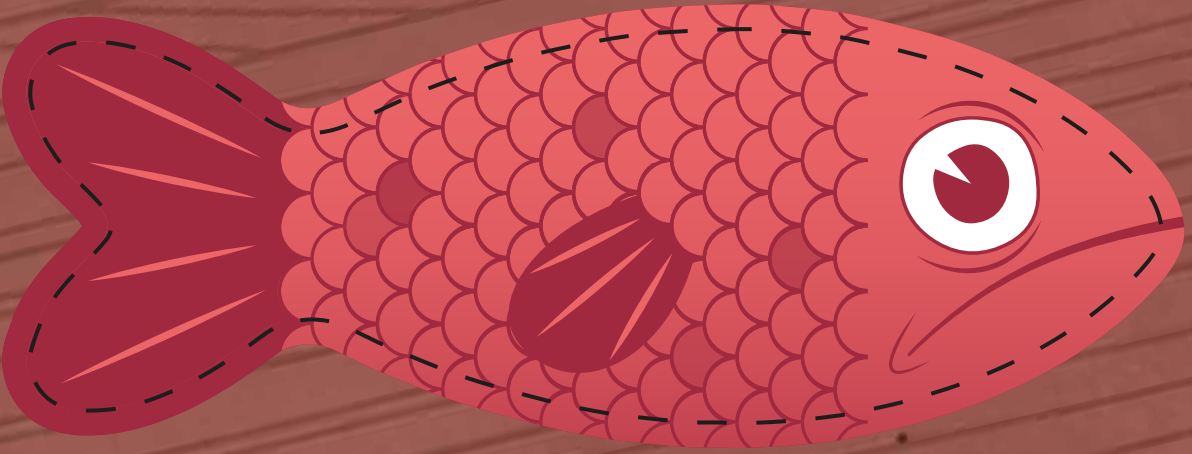
THE RULES

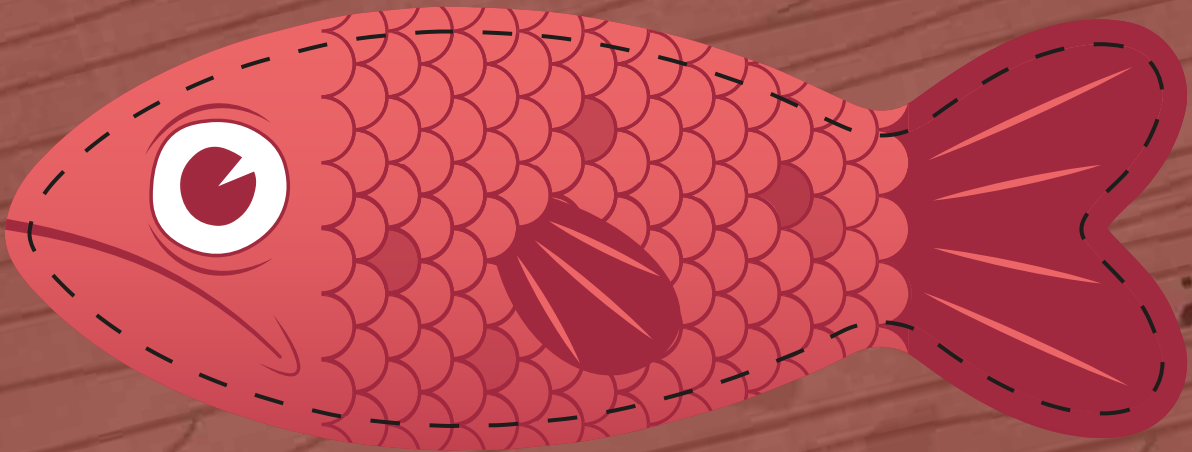
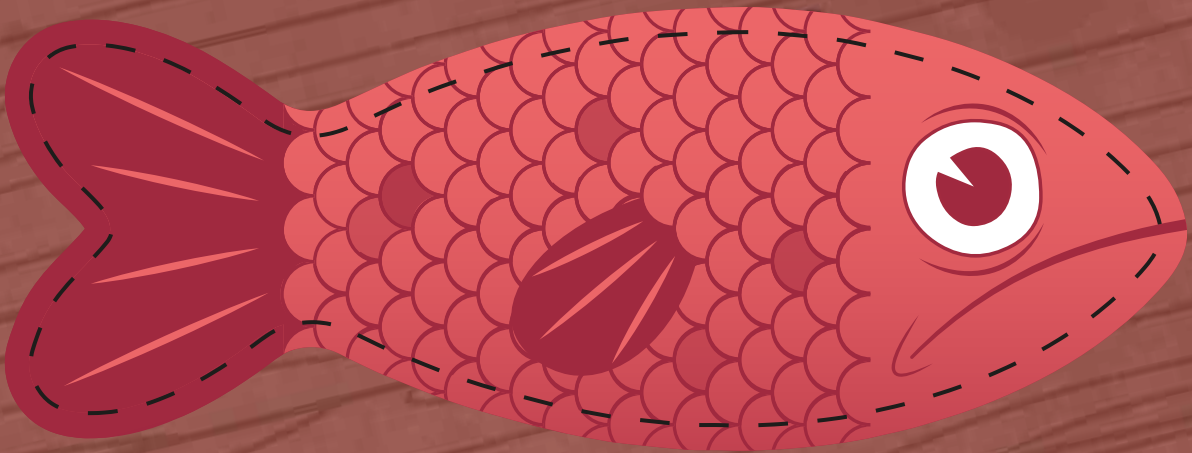
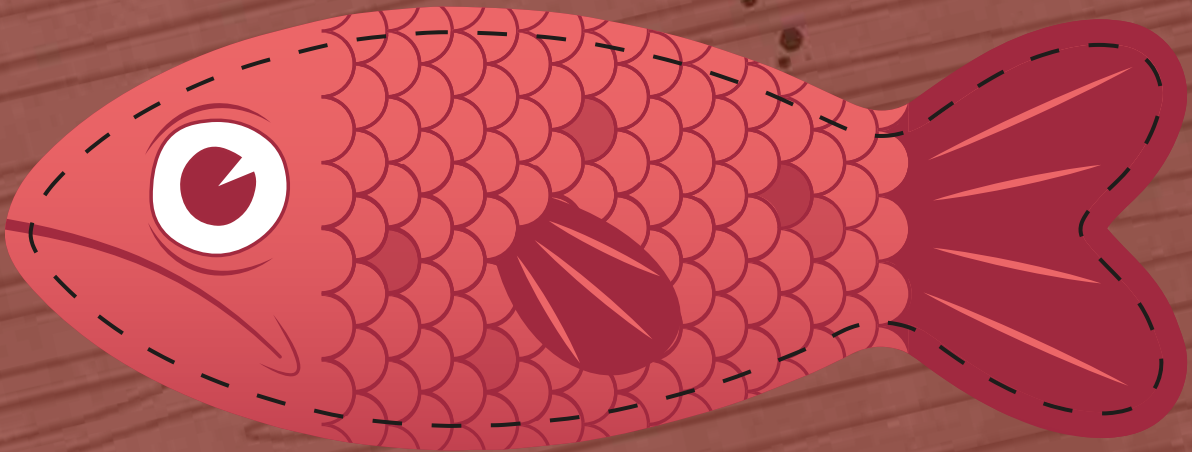
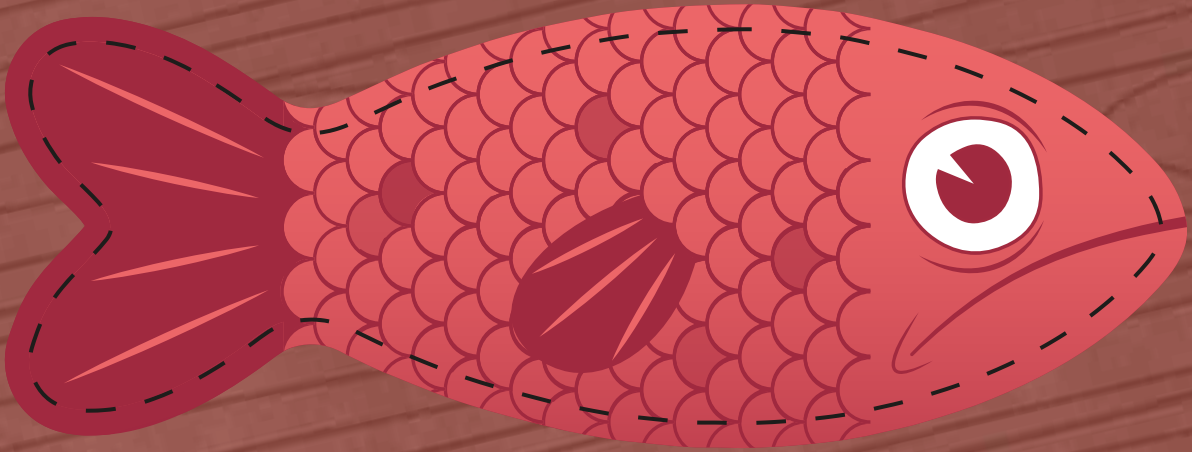
1. To start you'll need a minimum of four people.
 2. Choose a player to be the Guesser. Their mission is to identify the fake answers from the real one.
 3. Ask the Guesser to close their eyes. Secretly choose a new player to be the True Blue Kipper. (Make sure the Guesser doesn't know who.) Their mission is to say the answer on the card.
 4. Everyone else: you're the Red Herrings. Each of you must make up a fake answer to the question.
 5. Before you tell the Guesser they can open their eyes, make sure the other players have seen the question, and the question card is hidden from the Guesser.
 6. Ok, now a player reads out the question and each player says their answer.
 7. The Guesser now has to decide which answers were fake. If they correctly guess a fake answer, they win a point. They can stop and bank their points whenever they like, but if they hook the real answer before the end of the round, they lose them all.
 8. The player with the most points after you run out of cards is the winner.
