
### Kelli Anderson | Office Manager, 26 years experience

Tom Balding has a long history of combining welding and metal work with art and function. He grew up in Southern California and at a young age spent a lot of time in his father's welding shop. At 18 he started working at Hooker Headers as a production line welder and fabricator. Within a few months, management appreciated his skills and moved him to the custom department where he was building beautiful exhaust systems for exotic cars. Near the end of the 60's he was also involved in the development of sailboat hardware for his cousin Hobart Alter, better known as Hobie.

In 1973 Tom was certified to weld government aircraft parts and he started his own precision TIG welding business. Business boomed. However, welding thousands of parts and the growth and crowding of Southern California finally took its toll and in 1980 Tom decided to make the big change. His love of the outdoors and an interest in horses steered him to the small (very small!) town of Ucross, Wyoming, population twenty-five.

He bought a 2-year-old colt and a book on breaking and training. A few months later he was riding everyday doing assorted ranch work and volunteering for anything as long as he could ride his horse. Making a living in the cowboy state was a challenge; odd jobs, ranch work, carpentry. Nothing really panned out. However, one afternoon a knock on the door would mark a dramatic turn in his life. Standing there was the neighbor lady holding a broken bit; asking if he could weld it back together. Tom instantly knew what he was going to do. The next day he drove thirty miles to town to order business cards and Tom Balding Bits and Spurs was born. As they say: "The rest is history."

Today, although the business has expanded, Tom Balding and his small devoted team strive to maintain the highest standard in craftsmanship, design and materials.
