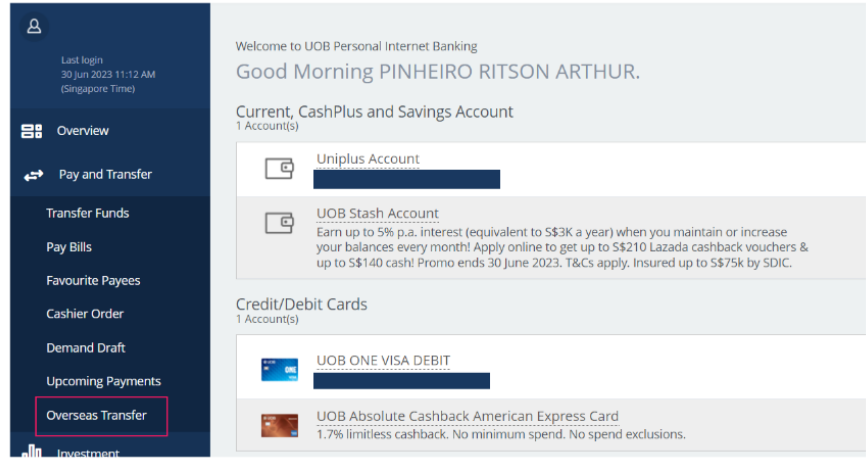


How to setup a NEW UOB Remittance Account and perform an Overseas Transfer

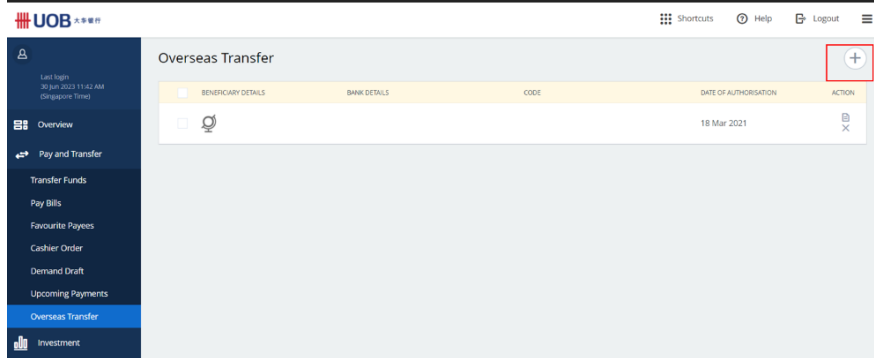
Step 1:

- Under Left Menu

Step 4:

- Make a remittance transaction.
 - Select Providence Foundation
 - Click Transfer

- Select any of your account from the dropdown list.
 - Key in the amount you want to transfer.

(suggest to transfer a small amount first to test it out. Once Sisters confirm receipt then do the remaining balance amount).

- Select **<Others>** from the dropdown list.
- Key in your name or information any for recipient reference.
- Click **<Continue>**
