

Do-It-Yourself Snag Plate

Tools Needed:

- Solgear Snag Plate Sticker Template
- Tape and Sissors and Alcohol prep pad
- 4" PVC Cap and Vise big enough to clamp it
- 5/8", 1/2", and 1/8" Drill Bit and Drill
- Dremel Tool with cut-off wheel and barrel sander
- Safety Glasses and Dust Mask

Instructions

1. Use Dremel with barrel sander to remove rough edges on outside of PVC cap and wipe clean with Alcohol.
2. Attach sticker to PVC cap. Make sure to align the bottom edge of sticker with the bottom of the PVC cap. There may be excess sticker on the top edge of PVC cap (Disregard).
3. Clamp PVC cap in vise.
4. Drill 1/8" hole on cross hairs of each orange circle as a pilot hole.
5. Drill 5/8" hole on each pilot hole.
6. Using Dremel with cut-off wheel, cut along black line to create snag hooks.
7. Sand rough edges using Dremel with barrel sander and remove Sticker.
8. Cut out bottom template and tape to bottom of PVC cap.
9. Drill 1/8" hole one cross hairs of each orange circle as pilot hole.
10. Remove bottom template and Drill 1/2" hole on center and 5/8" holes on remaining pilot holes.
11. Use barrel sander on Dremel to remove any rough edges of plastic.
