Thank you for choosing **Adelaide Party & Wedding Hire** for your event needs! Here's a step-by-step guide for our **Sand Wax Candles with Assorted Glass Cylinders**:

Begin by carefully inspecting all the items to ensure you have everything required: Candle Powder + Glass Cylinders (various sizes) + Scoop + Wicks + Funnel and Lighter or Matches (not supplied)

Unpack the Cylinders:

Choose a flat, heat-resistant surface to work on. Ensure the area is clean and free of clutter to avoid spills or accidents. Unpack the cylinders and arrange them neatly side by side to facilitate easy pouring.

Add the Powder Candle Wax:

Using a funnel and scoop, slowly pour the powder candle wax into the glass cylinder. Fill the cylinder to the desired level, leaving enough space at the top to avoid spills when the candle is lit.





Level the Powder:

Gently tap the glass cylinder on the surface to settle the powder evenly. Avoid packing the powder too tightly to ensure proper burning.

Insert the Wick:

Place the wick into the powder, ensuring that 1 cm remains above the wax surface. Use longer wicks for larger cylinders and shorter wicks for smaller ones.



Light the Candle:

Place the cylinder on a stable, heat-resistant surface and light the wick with a lighter or match.

Safety Tips:

- Never leave a burning candle unattended.
- Keep candles away from flammable objects and out of reach of children.
- Carefully handle glass cylinders, as they may become hot during use.
- Allow the cylinder to cool completely before refilling or moving.

Cleaning:

After the wax has melted during use, it will clump together with the burned wick.

Once cooled, remove this clump and dispose of it in the bin.

Then carefully return any leftover powder wax to its original container for reuse.

Lastly, clean the glass cylinders with a demp cloth to remove any remaining wax residue and then dry them thoroughly.

Storage:

Place the cleaned cylinders back in the provided box, wrapping each one individually in bubble wrap for protection. Ensure all items are securely packed to prevent damage during transport.
