

SETUP GUIDE

Thank you for choosing **Adelaide Wedding Hire** for your event needs! Setting up your **Speaker Package** is a breeze. Here's a step-by-step guide to get your party music started:

Unpacking and Inspection

Begin by unboxing your package and carefully inspect all the items to ensure everything is included: **2x Speakers + 2x Speaker Stands + 2x XLR Cables**

Setting Up the Speaker Stands

Find the **speaker stands** and extend it to your desired height. Place the speakers on top of the stands, ensuring it's securely positioned.

Connecting Your Audio Source

Locate the **XLR cable provided** and the **Input 1 audio source** on the back of the first speaker. Plug one end of the XLR cable to the Input 1 hole and plug the other end to your **audio source**. If you are using a phone to play music, you will need to plug **a phone adaptor** to the end of the XLR cable to match the plug size of your Iphone, Samsung or other phone model.

Connecting the Speakers to Each-Other

Locate the other **XLR cable** provided, the **mix output** on the back of the first speaker and the **Input 1** on the back of the second speaker. Plug one end of the XLR cable to the mix output hole on the back of the first speaker and plug the other end to the Input 1 hole on the back of the second speaker.

Powering Up the Speakers

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Locate the **power cords** that are provided and the **power switch** on the back of the speakers. Plug one end of the power cord to the power input hole on the back of each speaker next to the power switch button. Then plug the other end of the power cord into a power outlet. Turn the switch to the "On" position.

Playing Music and Adjusting the Volume

Find the **volume control knobs** located next to the Input 1 hole on the back of each speaker. Start playing your favorite music on your audio source and gradually increase the speaker's volume by rotating the volume control knobs to the desired level for your party.

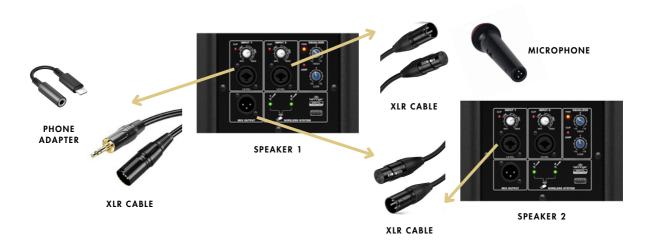


Fine-Tuning (if necessary)

Your Speakers has built-in equalizer settings and you can just leave those knobs at the 0 position for a standard tuning. If desired however, it is possible to use them to fine-tune the sound quality by rotating those knobs.

Unpacking and Connecting the Microphone

Unbox the **wired microphone** with the **XLR cable** provided, and locate the **Input 2 audio source** on the back of the first speaker. Plug one end of the XLR cable to the Input 2 hole and plug the other end to the microphone hole.

Test the Microphone and Adjust the Volume

Find the **volume control knob** located next to the Input 2 hole on the back of the first speaker. Speak into the microphone to test if it's working and gradually increase the volume by rotating the volume control knob to the desired level.

Speak Loud and Clear
