

SETUP GUIDE

Thank you for choosing **Adelaide Wedding Hire** for your event needs! Setting up your **Speaker 100W** is a breeze. Here's a step-by-step guide to get your party music started:

Unpacking and Inspection

1 Begin by unboxing your package and carefully inspect all the items to ensure everything is included: **Speaker 100W + Speaker Stand + XLR Cable**

Setting Up the Speaker Stand

2 Find the **speaker stand** and extend it to your desired height. Place the speaker on top of the stand, ensuring it's securely positioned.

Connecting Your Audio Source

Locate the **XLR cable provided** and the **Input 1 audio source** on the back of the speaker. Plug one end of the XLR cable to the Input 1 hole and plug the other end to your **audio source**. If you are using a phone to play music, you will need to plug **a phone adaptor** to the end of the XLR cable to match the plug size of your Iphone, Samsung or other phone model.

Powering Up the Speaker

Locate the **power cord** that is provided and the **power switch** on the back of the speaker. Plug one end of the power cord to the power input hole on the back of the speaker next to the power switch button. Then plug the other end of the power cord into a power outlet. Turn the power switch to the "On" position.

Playing Music and Adjusting the Volume

5 Find the **volume control knob** located next to the Input 1 hole on the back of the 5 speaker. Start playing your favorite music on your audio source and gradually increase the speaker's volume by rotating the volume control knob to the desired level for your party.

Fine-Tuning (if necessary)

Your Speaker 100W has built-in equalizer settings and you can just leave those knobs at the 0 position for a standard tuning. If desired however, it is possible to use them to fine-tune the sound quality according to your preference by rotating those knobs.

Unpacking and Connecting the Microphone

Unbox the **wired microphone** with the **XLR cable** provided, and locate the **Input 2 audio source** on the back of the speaker. Plug one end of the XLR cable to the Input 2 hole and plug the other end to the microphone hole.

Test the Microphone and Adjust the Volume

² Find the **volume control knob** located next to the Input 2 hole on the back of the speaker. Speak into the microphone to test if it's working and gradually increase the volume by rotating the volume control knob to the desired level.
