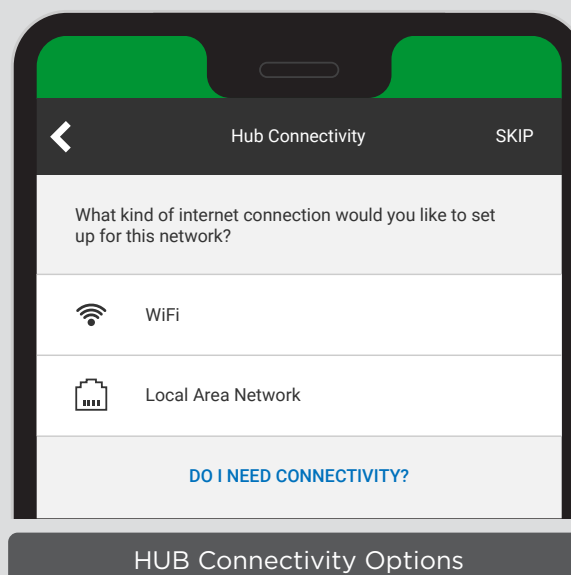


# Connecting Your MSA HUB to the Internet

## Connecting Your MSA HUB to the Internet to Access Safety io™ Grid Services

Begin by selecting either **WiFi** or **Local Area Network** (ethernet) in the Safety io Grid App.

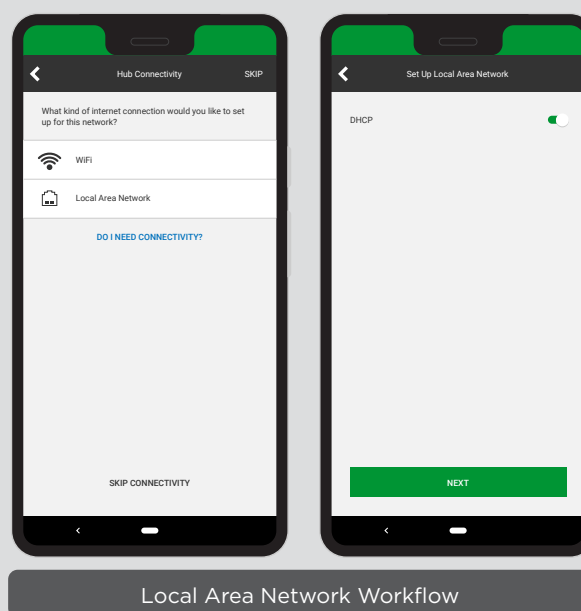
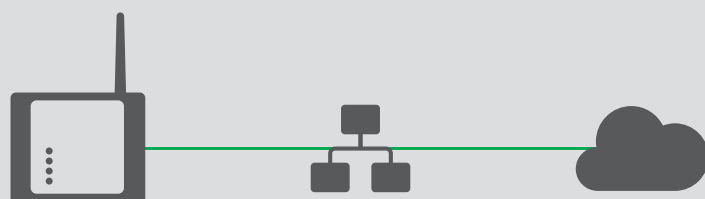


### A Ethernet

Using ethernet provides a more reliable connection to your network while connecting your HUB to the Grid.

Follow the instructions in the ALTAIR® io360 Gas Detector product manual to install the ethernet cable. Use the app to connect to the internet.

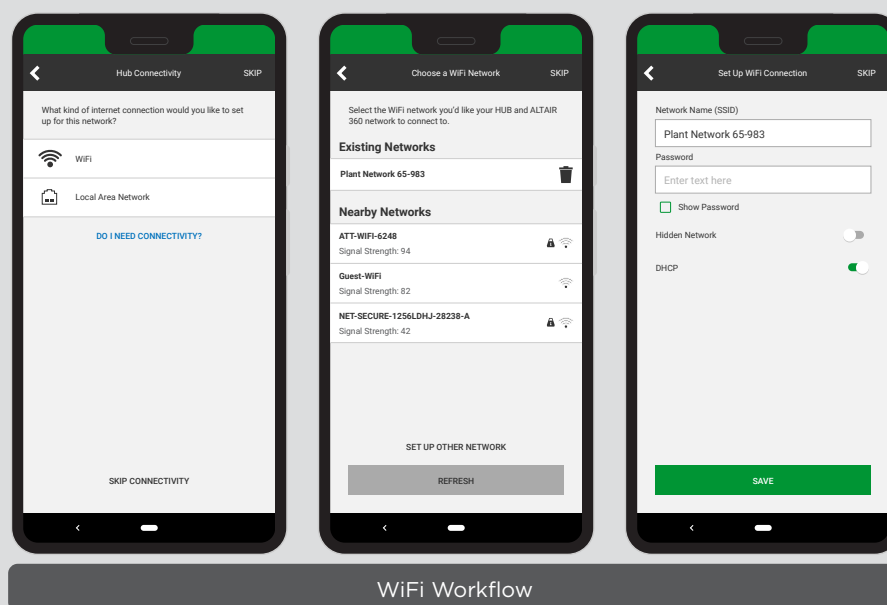
Ethernet cables can be purchased through MSA.



### B WiFi

The HUB can connect to the internet via WiFi. Password-protected WPA2 Personal is required.

Use the app to connect to the internet.



### C Cellular Hot Spot (WiFi or Ethernet)

Customers may prefer cellular connectivity due to site limitations and IT complexities.

Most major cellular providers and many connectivity companies like Sierra Wireless and Cradlepoint offer cellular hot spots with WiFi and/or ethernet connectivity. Models rated for class 1, div 2 locations are also available. Contact MSA for recommendations.
