

Determine Your Ring Size

- 1. Print this guide with page scaling set to 100%.
- 2. Place a credit card in the outline to check that the guide has been properly printed to scale. There should be a sliver of room around the card.
- 3. Place a ring that you already own (or have borrowed, if this is a surprise engagement or gift) over the circles below.
- 4. Match the inside of the ring to the circle nearest in size.
- 5. Consider width. The wider the band, the tighter it may feel. If you are in between sizes, and the ring has a thicker width, it may be better to order one size up. If you are in between sizes and the band is thinner, it may be better to order one size down.

This guide is only a reference. The most accurate method to determine your ring size is to have your finger sized at a jewelry store.
