

# Adventure Bike Pegs GS1 Installation Guide

Pegs can be installed 4 ways, horizontally above/below the bar or vertically front/behind the bar. The installed orientation will determine which peg is on the right or left side of the bike. The pegs are mirror images of each other. Pictured is installed below a horizontal bar and behind a vertical bar.

Pegs include 10 set screws for additional boot grip, which may be installed if desired. See back of install guide for more details about grip screw installation.



With a 3/16" hex wrench, remove half of the clamping collar, and loosely place each peg in the preferred location on the protection bar on your motorcycle. Reinstall the other half of the clamping collar, and evenly space the gaps on each side of the collar, with the screws only finger tight.

Before you tighten the clamping collar screws, do some visual inspections from several angles, including sitting on the bike, to be sure the pegs are in the positions you want. Make sure the pegs have room to retract and are "level" to your liking. When the position is ideal, gradually tighten each screw until the pegs are secure (70 in-lbs MAX).



You may also want to adjust how far the pegs "open" for maximum comfort. To do this, use a 3/32" hex wrench to screw in the #10-32 flat head set screw in small increments, until the pegs are "pushed back" to your liking.

Enjoy your new pegs! Please stop your bike in a safe place before attempting to retract or extend your Adventure Bike Pegs. DO NOT retract or extend your Adventure Bike Pegs while moving, for obvious safety reasons.

Install optional grip screws by putting one drop of the provided blue thread locker in the top of the threaded holes, allowing it to run into the threads. Thread the set screw in from the bottom. Adjust the screw height to your liking, and allow the thread locker to dry for 30 minutes before using or re-adjusting the screws.

Pictures below show grip screws installed on horizontal and vertical mounts, with pegs extended and retracted.
