### Instructions

All seam allowances are ½" (.64cm) and pieces are sewn right sides together. Press seam allowances open unless otherwise stated.


Randomly choose fabric prints for canning lids, pieces **NL** and **WL**, or use the **Quilt Layout** as a guide. All canning lids in the diagrams are gray.

1. Draw a line along one diagonal on the wrong side of the **Z18**, **Z19** and **Z20** squares.

#### **Small Jars**


2. Place a **Z19** square on the lower right-hand corner of (1) **SV** rectangle, right sides together, matching the raw edges and positioning the drawn line so it runs across the corner. Sew along the drawn line and trim the seam allowance to ½" (.64cm). Press (**Fig. 1**) Repeat to sew a **Z19** square on the lower left corner.

3. Select a WL piece and sew to the top of the SV rectangle to complete (1) Small Jar ( $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{4}$ " (11.42cm x 15.88cm)). (**Fig. 2**)

**4.** Repeat Steps 1 and 2 to make a total of (12) Small Jars.

#### **Medium Jars**

Repeat the process in Step 2 to sew
 z19 squares to all four corners of (1) MV rectangle. (Fig. 3)

6. Select an **NL** piece and sew between (2) **Z22** rectangles. Sew the lid to the top of the **MV** rectangle to complete (1) Medium Jar (5½" x 11¼" (13.97cm x 28.58cm)). (**Fig. 4**)

7. Repeat Steps 5 and 6 to make a total of (9) Medium Jars.

### Large Jar

8. Repeat the process in Step 2 to sew **Z19** squares to all four corners of the LV rectangle. (Fig. 5)

9. Select a NL piece and sew between (2) Z21 rectangles. Sew the lid to the top of the LV rectangle to complete (1) Large Jar (7½" x  $13\frac{1}{4}$ " (19.05cm x 33.66cm)). (**Fig. 6**)

### Extra-large Jars

10. Repeat the process in Step 2 to sew Z18 squares to all four corners of (1) XLV rectangle. (Fig. 7)

11. Select a WL piece and sew between (2) Z21 rectangles. Sew the lid to the top of the XLV rectangle to complete (1) Extra-large Jar  $(8\frac{1}{2}$ " X  $14\frac{1}{4}$ " (21.59cm x 36.20cm)). (**Fig. 8**)




12. Repeat Steps 10 and 11 to make a total of (2) Extra-large Jars.

#### **Potted Plant 1**

13. Repeat the process in Step 2 to sew Z19 squares to the upper left corner of Q1, the upper and lower left corners of Q2, the upper right corner of Q3, the upper right and both lower corners of Q4, and the lower corners of rectangles T1 and T2. Set aside Q4. (Fig. 9)



14. Sew the Z16 rectangle to the top of Q2. Sew the pieced section to the left side of Q1. Sew the Z8 rectangle to the top of the **Q1/2** section. (**Fig. 10**)

15. Sew the Z11 square to the top of Q3 and sew to right side of the Q1/2 pieced section. Sew the resulting piece to the top of the T1, then the T2 rectangles. (Fig. 11)

**16.** Sew the **Z5** rectangle to the top and the **Z16** rectangle to the bottom of **Q4**. Sew the pieced section to the right side of the section in Step 15 to complete the Potted Plant 1 Block (11½" x 16½" (29.21cm x 41.91cm)). (**Fig. 12**)





#### **Potted Plant 2**


17. Repeat the process in Step 2 to sew Z19 squares to both upper corners of rectangle R1, the upper left corner of R2 and R3, and the lower corners of rectangles S1 and S2. (Fig. 13)



**18.** Repeat the process in Step 2 to sew **Z20** squares to the remaining corners of **R1**, **R2** and **R3**. (**Fig. 14**)




19. Sew the Z13 rectangle to the top of R1, the Z9 rectangle to the top of R2 and the Z7 rectangle to the top of R3. Sew R1 between R2 and R3. Sew a Z4 strip to each side. (Fig. 15)



**20.** Sew the pieced **R** section to the top of **\$1**, then to the **\$2** rectangle to complete the Potted Plant 2 Block (6½" x 16½" (16.51cm x 41.91cm)). (**Fig. 16**)

# **Quilt Top Assembly**

**Note:** Follow the **Quilt Layout** diagram while assembling the quilt.

#### Row 1

- **21.** Sew (4) Small Jars together into a four patch. Sew a **Z15** rectangle to the top of the Small Jars. Repeat to make (2) Small Jar stacks  $(8\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $14\frac{1}{2}$ " (21.59cm x 36.83cm)).
- **22.** Sew a **Z14** rectangle to the top of (4) Medium Jars.
- **23.** Sew the Small Jar stacks and Medium Jars together, alternating with (5) **Z2** strips. Sew a **Z3** strip to each end to complete Row 1  $(42\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $14\frac{1}{2}$ " (107.95cm x 36.83cm)).

#### Row 2

- 24. Repeat Step 21 to make (1) Small Jar stack.
- **25.** Sew a **Z14** rectangle to the top of (4) Medium Jars.
- **26.** Sew the **Z12** rectangle to the top of the Large Jar.
- 27. Sew the Small Jar stack and Medium and Large Jars together, alternating with (7) 22 strips to complete Row 2 (42½" x 14½" (107.95cm x 36.83cm)).

### Row 3

- **28.** Sew the **Z6** rectangle to the top of (1) Medium Jar.
- **29.** Sew a **Z17** rectangle to the top of (2) X-Large Jars.
- **30.** Sew the Potted Plant Blocks and Medium and X-Large Jars together, alternating with (4) Z1 strips to complete Row 3 ( $42\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $16\frac{1}{2}$ " (107.95cm x 41.91cm)).

### Sashing and Borders

- **31.** Sew the (3) 2" (5.08cm) **Fabric X** strips together end to end. Cut (2)  $42\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2" (107.95cm x 5.08cm) Shelves.
- **32.** Sew the Shelves between the Rows to complete the Quilt Center  $(42\frac{1}{2}\text{"} \times 47\frac{1}{2}\text{"} (107.95\text{cm} \times 120.65\text{cm}))$ .
- **33.** Sew the  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $47\frac{1}{2}$ " (6.35cm x 120.65cm) **Fabric Z** side borders to each side of the Ouilt Center.
- **34.** Sew the (2)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " (6.35cm) **Fabric Z** border strips together end to end. Cut (1)  $46\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " (118.11cm x 6.35cm) top border. Sew the top border to the top of the Quilt Center.
- **35.** Sew the (2)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " (6.35cm) **Fabric Y** strips together end to end. Cut (1)  $46\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " (118.11cm x 6.35cm) Counter. Sew the Counter to the bottom of the Quilt Center to complete the Quilt Top ( $46\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $51\frac{1}{2}$ " (118.11cm x 130.81cm)).

# Finishing

- **36.** Sew together the (6) 2½" (6.35cm) **Fabric P** binding strips end to end using diagonal seams. Press seams open. Press the binding strip in half wrong sides together.
- **37.** Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, and quilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with the top (square side edges if not completed in Step 5) after quilting is completed.
- **38.** Leaving an 8" (20.32cm) tail of binding, sew the binding to the top of the quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12"

- (30.48cm) from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where the loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding right sides together. Trim seam to ½" (.64cm) and press open. Finish sewing binding to quilt.
- **39.** Turn the binding to the back of quilt and hand-stitch in place.

#### Top Border
