

ADDITIONAL TOOLS NEEDED: BASIC SEWING SUPPLIES



HST = HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE, SNF = STITCH AND FLIP



CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Fabric 1:

- A (4) 3" squares
- B (4) 1 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles
- C (4) 2 ½" squares

Fabric 2:

• D – (2) 3" squares

Fabric 3:

• E – (1) 2 ½" square

Fabric 4:

- F (2) 3" squares
- G (4) 1 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles

SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (4) A squares. Place (2) A – squares aside for Step 3.
- 2. Place (2) A squares with (2) D squares, right sides together. Sew a ¼" away from both sides of the drawn diagonal line on each set of squares. Cut along the drawn diagonal lines, making (4) A/D HST units. Trim HST units to measure 2 ½" x 2 ½" unfinished.












3. Repeat HST unit assembly to make (4) A/F HST units.



- 4. Arrange (4) A/D HST units with (4) C squares and (1) E square to form the center of Block 5.
- 5. Sew together as shown. Arrows indicate pressing instructions. The center of Block 5 should measure 6 ½" x 6 ½" unfinished.



- 6. Arrange (4) A/F HST units, the center of Block 5, (4) B rectangles and (4) G – rectangles to form Block 5.
- 7. Sew the block together as shown, pressing seams toward the B and G – rectangles. Once complete, Block 5 should measure 10 ½" x 10 ½" unfinished.
