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## Cutting Instructions

Fabric 1:

- A - (3) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
- $B-(6) 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares

Fabric 2:

- C - (6) $21 / 2 / 2$ squares

Fabric 3:

- $D-(3) 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles

Fabric 4:

- E - (3) $211 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2 \prime$ rectangles

HST = Half SQUARE Triangle, SNF = Stitch And Flip

## Fabric 5:

- $F$ - (6) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares

Fabric 6:

- $G-(1) 2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ square

Fabric 7:

- $H$ - (6) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares


## Fabric 8:

- I - (3) $2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles


## Sewing Instructions

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (6) $B$ - squares,
(6) $C$ - squares, (6) $F$ - squares and (6) $H$ - squares. Use the $B$ - squares in Steps 2 and 3. Set the remaining squares aside for Step 4.
2. Place (1) B - square onto the top left corner of (3) Erectangles, right sides together. Sew along the drawn diagonal lines. Trim excess corner fabric to a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$. Press toward the corners.
3. Repeat SNF techniques to attach (1) B-square to the top right corner of the same E - rectangles to make (3) flying geese units measuring $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished

4. Repeat flying geese unit assembly to make (3) additional flying geese unit colorways ( $A / C, D / H$ and I/F). Reference the diagrams for the fabric combinations. Make (3) of each additional colorway.

5. Arrange flying geese units and (1) G - square to form Block 10 .
6. Sew the block together as shown. Arrows indicate pressing instructions. Once complete, Block 10 should measure $101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x $101 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished.
