FINISHED QUILT SIZE 69½" x 84½"

Finished Block Size 15" x 15"

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 Fancy Free FQ Pack (FQ-4060-18)

1 FQ lemon shade (C200-61 Lemon)

1 FQ teal shade (C200-32 Teal)

½ yard (50 cm) snow white shade (C200-03 Snow White)

Binding ¾ yard (70 cm)

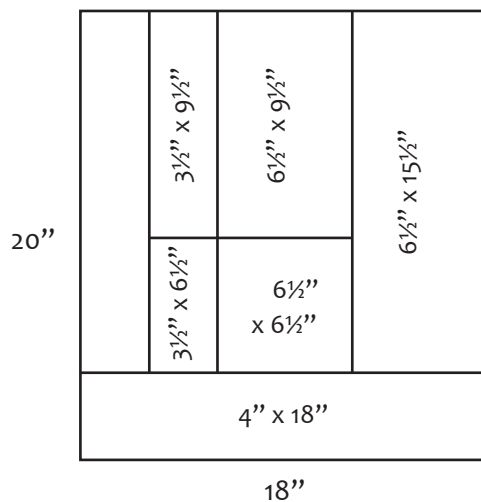
Backing 5¼ yards (4.85 m)

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

FQ Pack, Lemon Shade and Teal Shade FQs

Cut the 20 FQs as diagrammed



Cut a 4" x 16" rectangle from each of the following assorted print 4" x 18" rectangles:

teal main, pink bikes, teal bikes, multi pinwheels, pink pinwheels, teal pinwheels, multi dots, green floral, orange floral, pink floral

Cut a 4" x 17⅞" rectangle from each of the following assorted print 4" x 18" rectangles:

pink main, white main, yellow bikes, pink dots, yellow dots, multi stripe, pink stripe, teal stripe

Snow White Shade

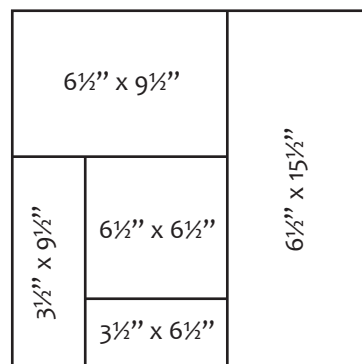
Cut 7 strips 1¾" x WOF for Border 1

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to quilt photo for placement of blocks.

Fancy Free Block

Refer to the diagram for piece placement. Sew an assorted print 3½" x 6½" rectangle to an assorted print 6½" x 6½" square. Sew an assorted print 3½" x 9½" rectangle to the top. Sew an assorted print 6½" x 9½" rectangle to the side. Sew an assorted print 6½" x 15½" rectangle to the bottom. Repeat to create 20 Fancy Free Blocks.



Quilt Center Assembly

See quilt photo for Fancy Free Block placement. Lay out blocks in 5 rows of 4 blocks. Sew rows together to complete the center of the quilt.

Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end if necessary to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

Border 1

Side borders should be 75½". Top and bottom borders should be 63".

Border 2

Refer to the quilt photo for piece placement. Sew 5 assorted print 4" x 16" rectangles together for the right side border. Sew 5 assorted print 4" x 16" rectangles together for the left side border. Sew the right and left side borders to the quilt. Sew 4 assorted print 4" x 17⅞" rectangles together for the top border. Sew 4 assorted print 4" x 17⅞" rectangles together for the bottom border. Sew the top and bottom borders to the quilt.

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Riley Blake fabric from the Fancy Free Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
