## Cutting Instructions

Fabric 1:

- A - (8) $3^{\prime \prime}$ squares

Fabric 2:

- B - (4) $3^{\prime \prime}$ squares


## Fabric 3:

- $C-(4) 3^{\prime \prime}$ squares

Confetti Cotton Solids MATERIALS by Riley blake Designs
Riley White (Fabric 1) Lipstick (Fabric 2) Jazzberry (Fabric 3)

Seafoam (Fabric 4)
Rain Forest (Fabric 5)

Fabric 4:

- $D-(4) 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles

Fabric 5:

- $E-(1) 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square


## Sewing Instructions

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (8) $A$ - squares. Use (4) squares in Step 2. Set (4) squares aside for Step 3.
2. Place (4) A - squares with (4) B - squares, right sides together. Sew a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away from both sides of the drawn diagonal line on each set of squares. Cut along the drawn diagonal lines, making (8) A/B HST units. Trim HST units to measure $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished.

3. Arrange the HST units with the remaining cut pieces ( $D$ and E) to form Block 6. Note the rotation of HST units in each corner of Block 6.
4. Sew the block together as shown. Arrows indicate pressing instructions. Once complete, Block 6 should measure $101 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ $101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished.
