

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Fabric 1:

• A – (8) 3" squares

Fabric 2:

• B – (4) 3" squares

Fabric 3:

• C – (4) 3" squares



HST = HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE

Fabric 4:

• D – (4) 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles

Fabric 5:

• $E - (1) 2 \frac{1}{2}$ " square

SEWING INSTRUCTIONS


- 1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (8) A squares. Use (4) squares in Step 2. Set (4) squares aside for Step 3.
- 2. Place (4) A squares with (4) B squares, right sides together. Sew a ¼" away from both sides of the drawn diagonal line on each set of squares. Cut along the drawn diagonal lines, making (8) A/B HST units. Trim HST units to measure 2 ½" x 2 ½" unfinished.














3. Repeat HST unit assembly to make (8) A/C HST units.



- 4. Arrange the HST units with the remaining cut pieces (D and E) to form Block 6. Note the rotation of HST units in each corner of Block 6.
- 5. Sew the block together as shown. Arrows indicate pressing instructions. Once complete, Block 6 should measure 10 ½" x 10 ½" unfinished.
