

# Botanical Garden

## FINISHED QUILT SIZE 84" x 84"

#### Finished Block Size 20" x 20"

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

#### **FABRIC REQUIREMENTS**

1/4 yard (25 cm) multi main (C5080 Multi)

1/4 yard (25 cm) berry flowers (C5081 Berry)

1% yards (1.5 m) multi flowers (C5081 Multi)

1/4 yard (25 cm) teal flowers (C5081 Teal)

¾ yard (70 cm) berry damask (C5082 Berry)

% yard (35 cm) green damask (C5082 Green)

% yard (35 cm) teal damask (C5082 Teal)

1/4 yard (25 cm) berry stripe (C5083 Berry)

¼ yard (25 cm) multi stripe (C5083 Multi)

¼ yard (25 cm) teal stripe (C5083 Teal)

1/4 yard (25 cm) berry circles (C5084 Berry)

¼ yard (25 cm) orange circles (C5084 Orange)

1/4 yard (25 cm) teal circles (C5084 Teal)

¼ yard (25 cm) berry criss-cross (C5085 Berry)

3¾ yards (3.1 m) cream criss-cross (C5085 Cream)

1 yard (95 cm) teal criss-cross (C5085 Teal)

Binding 1 yard (95 cm)

Backing 7¾ yards (7.05 m)

## **CUTTING REQUIREMENTS**

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

#### **Assorted Prints**

Cut squares 6" x 6" in the corresponding number from each of the following assorted prints:

4-multi main, 1-berry flowers, 3-teal flowers,

1-berry stripe, 4-multi stripe, 3-teal stripe,

2-berry circles, 4-orange circles, 3-teal circles,

2-berry criss-cross

#### Assorted Prints (Continued)

Cut squares 10%" x 10%" in the corresponding number from each of the following assorted prints. Cut each square once diagonally to make 18 large triangles.

4-berry damask, 3-green damask, 2-teal damask

# Multi Flowers

Cut 8 strips 6½" x WOF for Border 2.

## **Cream Criss-Cross**

Cut 6 strips 5%" x WOF. Cut the strips into 36 squares 5%" x 5%".

Cut 5 strips 6" x WOF. Cut the strips into 27 squares 6" x 6". Cut 3 strips 5%" x WOF. Cut the strips into 18 squares 5%" x 5%". Cut the squares once diagonally to make 36 small triangles.

Cut 6 strips  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strips into 12 rectangles  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $20\frac{1}{2}$ ".

## **Teal Criss-Cross**

Cut 1 strip 3½" x WOF. Cut the strip into 4 squares 3½" x 3½".

Cut 7 strips 3½" x WOF for Border 1.

## QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to the quilt photo for placement of fabrics as each block is a different combination of fabrics.

#### Garden Block

Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the cream criss-cross 6" squares. Place a cream criss-cross 6" square on top of an assorted print 6" square. Sew ¼" on each side of the line. Cut on the line to make 2 Half Square Triangles. Press. Repeat to make 54 Half Square Triangles. Square up the Half Square Triangles to 5½".

# **Botanical Garden**

Sew 2 cream criss-cross 5½" x 5½" squares and 2 Half Square Triangles together to create Unit A. Press. Repeat to make 18 Unit As.



Unit A

Sew 2 small cream criss-cross triangles to a Half Square Triangle to create Unit B. Repeat to make 18 Unit Bs.



Unit E

Sew a large damask triangle to a Unit B to create Unit C. Repeat to create 18 Unit Cs.



Unit C

Sew 2 Unit As and 2 Unit Cs together to create the Garden Block. Repeat to make 9 Garden Blocks.

#### Garden Block and Sashing

Refer to the Quilt Center Diagram for block and sashing placement. Sew a Garden Block to a cream criss-cross 3½" x 20½" rectangle. Repeat to make a row with 3 Garden Blocks and 2 sashing rectangles. Make 3 block and sashing rows.

#### Sashing and Posts

Refer to the Quilt Center Diagram for sashing and post placement. Sew a cream criss-cross 3%" x 20%" rectangle to a teal criss-cross 3%" square. Repeat to make a row with 3 sashing rectangles and 2 posts. Make 2 sashing and post rows.

# Quilt Center Assembly

Refer to the Quilt Center Diagram for row placement. Sew rows together to complete the center of the quilt.

#### **Borders**

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end if necessary to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

#### Border 1

Side borders should be 66%". Top and bottom borders should be 72%".

#### Border 2

Side borders should be 72%". Top and bottom borders should be 84%".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Riley Blake fabric from the Botanique Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
