#### FINISHED QUILT SIZE 58" x 58"

# Finished Block Size 20" x 20"

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

#### **FABRIC REQUIREMENTS**

1/2 Yard SC10380 Gold Main

% Yard SC10381 Gold Birds

1/2 Yard SC10382 Gold Branches

% Yard C10382 Red Branches

1/4 Yard SC10383 Gold Paisley

1⅓ Yards C10383 Red Paislev

1/2 Yard SC10384 Gold Twigs

1 Yard C10384 Red Twigs

1/2 Yard SC10385 Gold Wicker

3/4 Yard C10385 Red Wicker

⅓ Yard Binding

# **CUTTING REQUIREMENTS**

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

# **Red Paisley**

Cut 6 strips 4½" x WOF for Border 4.

Cut 1 strip 3" x WOF. Cut the strip into 4 rectangles 3" x 5½" and 4 squares 3" x 3".

Cut 2 strips 5½" x WOF. Cut the strips into 8 squares 5½" x 5½".

# **Gold Paisley**

Cut 1 strip  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strip into 1 square  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " and 8 squares 3" x 3".

# Gold Main

Cut 1 strip 3" x WOF. Cut the strip into 4 rectangles 3" x 5½" and 4 squares 3" x 3".

Cut 2 strips  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strips into 8 squares  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $5\frac{1}{2}$ ".

#### **Red Branches**

Cut 2 strips 3" x WOF. Cut the strip into 4 rectangles 3" x 5½" and 20 squares 3" x 3".

Cut 2 strips 5½" x WOF. Cut the strips into 10 squares 5½" x 5½".

#### **Gold Branches**

Cut 1 strip 3" x WOF. Cut the strip into 4 rectangles 3" x 5½" and 4 squares 3" x 3".

Cut 2 strips 5½" x WOF. Cut the strips into 8 squares 5½" x 5½".

#### **Gold Birds**

Cut 2 strips 5½" x WOF. Cut the strips into 4 rectangles 5½" x 10½" and 4 squares 5½" x 5½".

### **Red Twigs**

Cut 2 strips 5%" x WOF. Cut the strips into 4 rectangles 5%" x 10%" and 4 squares 5%" x 5%".

Cut 5 strips 3½" x WOF for Border 2.

#### **Gold Twigs**

Cut 1 strip 3" x WOF. Cut the strip into 8 squares 3" x 3". Cut 2 strips 5½" x WOF. Cut the strips into 4 rectangles 5½" x 10½" and 5 squares 5½" x 5½".

#### **Red Wicker**

Cut 2 strips 5½" x WOF. Cut the strips into 4 rectangles 5½" x 10½" and 4 squares 5½" x 5½".

#### **Gold Wicker**

Cut 9 strips 1½" x WOF for Borders 1 and 3.

# **CLASSIC STAR**

#### **QUILT ASSEMBLY**

Refer to quilt photo for placement of fabrics as each block is a different combination of fabrics.

#### Classic Star Block

These instructions are to make 1 block. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 8 assorted print 3" squares. Place an assorted print 3" square on top of an assorted print 3" x 5½" rectangle and sew on the line. Leave a ½" seam allowance and trim excess. Press. Repeat on the other side. This will make 1 Small Flying Geese Unit. Repeat to make 4 Small Flying Geese Units.



Small Flying Geese Unit

Sew a Small Flying Geese Unit to the left and right side of an assorted print 5½" square. Sew an assorted print 3" square to each side of the 2 remaining Small Flying Geese Units. Sew the 3 rows together to complete the Center Star.



Center Star

Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 8 assorted print 5½" squares. Place an assorted print 5½" square on top of an assorted print 5½" x 10½" rectangle and sew on the line. Leave a ¼" seam allowance and trim excess. Press. Repeat on the other side. This will make 1 Large Flying Geese Unit. Repeat to make 4 Large Flying Geese Units.



Large Flying Geese Unit

Sew a Large Flying Geese Unit to the left and right side of the Center Star. Sew an assorted print 5½" square to each side of the 2 remaining Large Flying Geese Units. Sew the 3 rows together to complete the Classic Star Block. Repeat to create 4 Classic Star Blocks.

#### **Borders**

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end if necessary to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

#### Border 1

Side borders should be 40%". Top and bottom borders should be 42%".

# Border 2

Side borders should be 42%". Top and bottom borders should be 48%".

## **Border 3**

Side borders should be 48%". Top and bottom borders should be 50%".

# **Border 4**

Side borders should be 50½". Top and bottom borders should be 58½".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Riley Blake fabric from the Classic Caskata Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
