

## High Flying Adventure

FINISHED QUILT SIZE 64" x 79"
Finished Flying Geese Size $3 " \times 6 "$
Measurements include $1 / 4$ " seam allowance.
Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.
Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

$11 / 2$ yards ( 1.4 m ) aqua main (C5140 Aqua)
$3 / 8$ yard ( 35 cm ) aqua clouds (C5141 Aqua)
$1 / 4$ yard ( 25 cm ) navy clouds (C5141 Navy)
$1 / 2$ yard ( 50 cm ) aqua camp (C5142 Aqua)
$1 / 4$ yard ( 25 cm ) blue camp (C5142 Blue)
$1 / 4$ yard ( 25 cm ) blue map (C5143 Blue)
$1 / 4$ yard ( 25 cm ) gray map (C5143 Gray)
$1 / 4$ yard ( 25 cm ) gray text (C5144 Gray)
$3 / 8$ yard ( 35 cm ) red text (C5144 Red)
$11 / 4$ yards ( 1.15 m ) green arrows (C5145 Green)
$25 / 8$ yards ( 2.45 m ) multi arrows (C5145 Multi)
$1 / 4$ yard ( 25 cm ) navy arrows (C5145 Navy)
Binding $5 / 8$ yard ( 60 cm )
Backing 478 yards ( 4.5 m )

## CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting sashing and border pieces.

## Aqua Main

Cut 7 strips 6½" x WOF for Border 2.

## Aqua Clouds

Cut 3 strips $312^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF. Cut the strips into 13 rectangles $3122^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2 "$.

## Navy Clouds

Cut 2 strips $312^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF. Cut the strips into 8 rectangles $31122^{14} \times 1 / 22^{\prime \prime}$.

## Blue Camp

Cut 2 strips $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF. Cut the strips into 11 rectangles $31 / 2$ " $61 / 2$ ".

## Blue Map

Cut 2 strips $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF. Cut the strips into 8 rectangles $3122^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2 "$.

## Gray Map

Cut 2 strips $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF. Cut the strips into 10 rectangles $31 / 2$ x 6 $1 / 22^{\prime \prime}$.

## Gray Text

Cut 2 strips $312^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF. Cut the strips into 8 rectangles $31 / 2$ " $\times 1$ ¹2".

## Red Text

Cut 3 strips $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF. Cut the strips into 17 rectangles $31 / 2$ " $\times 1 / 22^{\prime \prime}$.

## Green Arrows

Cut 10 strips $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF. Sew the strips together end to end and cut 6 rectangles $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 631 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ for Sashing.

## Multi Arrows

Cut 20 strips $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF. Cut the strips into 210 squares $3122^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2$ ".
Cut 6 strips $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF for Border 1 .

## Navy Arrows

Cut 2 strips $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF. Cut the strips into 8 rectangles $31 / 21$ x $61 / 22^{\prime \prime}$.

## QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to Quilt Center Diagram for placement of fabrics.

## Flying Geese

Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the multi arrows $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Place a multi arrows $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square on top of an assorted print $31 / 2$ " $\times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle and sew on the line. Leave a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance and trim excess. Press. Repeat on the other side. This will make 1 Flying Geese. Repeat to create 105 Flying Geese.


## High Flying Adventure

Quilt Center Assembly
Refer to the Quilt Center Diagram for Flying Geese placement. Sew 21 Flying Geese together to create a column. Repeat to make 5 columns of Flying Geese. Sew the Flying Geese columns and the 6 green arrows $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 631 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sashing rectangles together to create the quilt center.

## Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end if necessary to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

## Border 1

Side borders should be $631 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Top and bottom borders should be 5212".

## Border 2

Side borders should be 67½". Top and bottom borders should be 6412".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Riley Blake fabric from the Greatest Adventure Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
