## Jewel in the Night

## FINISHED QUILT SIZE 60" x 72"

Finished Block Size 10" x 10"
Measurements include $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance.
Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 Parisian Fat Quarter Stack (FQ-4630-15)
$11 / 4$ yards ( 1.15 m ) white main (C4630 White)
$1 / 2$ yard 50 cm ) yellow dot (C4634 Yellow)
$27 / 8$ yards ( 2.65 m ) clean white solid (C100-01 Clean White)
Binding $5 / 8$ yard ( 60 cm )
Backing 33/4 yards ( 3.45 m)

## CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

## Fat Quarter Stack

Cut 4 squares $3^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ and 34 squares $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime}$ from black dot.
Cut 8 squares $3^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ and 28 squares $2^{1 / 2 \prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ from black diamond.
Cut 4 squares $3^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ and 4 squares $2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{\prime^{\prime \prime}}$ from each of the following fat quarters:
white main, yellow main, yellow scroll, white diamond, yellow medallion
Cut 8 squares $3^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ and 8 squares $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21^{\prime \prime}$ from each of the following fat quarters:
black main, black scroll, gray scroll, black medallion, gray diamond, gray medallion

## White Main

Cut 6 strips $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF for Border 1.

## Yellow Dot

Cut 5 strips $21^{\prime 1} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF. Cut the strips into 80 squares $2 \frac{1}{1} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{1 \prime \prime} 2^{\prime \prime}$.

## Clean White Solid

Cut 10 strips $2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF. Cut the strips into 160 squares $2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$.
Cut 7 strips $3^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF. Cut the strips into 80 squares $3^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$.
Cut 4 strips $101 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF. Cut the strips into 49 rectangles $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ for sashing.

## Jewel Block

Refer to the quilt photo for piece placement as each block is a different combination of fabrics. Draw a line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the clean white solid 3 " squares. Place the clean white solid $3^{\prime \prime}$ squares on top of the assorted print $3^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the lines to make 160 Half Square Triangles. Press. Square up the Half Square Triangles to $212^{\prime \prime}$.

Refer to the block diagram for placement of 8 clean white solid $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares, 8 Half Square Triangles, 4 assorted print $2^{1 ⁄ 2 \prime} 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares, 4 yellow dot $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares, and 1 black diamond $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Lay out the squares in 5 rows of 5 squares. Sew the rows together to create the Jewel Block. Repeat to make 20 Jewel Blocks.

## Posts and Sashing

Refer to quilt photo for post and sashing placement. Sew a black dot $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square to a clean white solid $21 / 2 \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Repeat to make a row with 5 posts and 4 sashing rectangles. Make 6 post and sashing rows.

## Sashing and Blocks

Refer to quilt photo for block and sashing placement. Sew a clean white solid $21 / 2 \times 10 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to a Jewel Block. Repeat to make a row with 5 sashing rectangles and 4 blocks. Make 5 sashing and block rows.

## Quilt Center Assembly

Refer to quilt photo for row placement. Sew rows together to complete the center of the quilt.

## Border

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end if necessary to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

## Border 1

Side borders should be 621⁄2". Top and bottom borders should be $601 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Riley Blake fabric from the Parisian Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
