





# FINISHED QUILT SIZE: 57" × 75"

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

### FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Assorted Hello Winter prints 6" × 21" of the following:

F11940 Red Main F11940 Black Main F11940 Taupe Main F11941 Red Stockings F11941 Taupe Stockings F11942 Black Stripe F11942 Taupe Stripe F11943 Multi Snowflakes

1½ yards Multi Winter Dots (F11944)

F11943 Black Snowflakes

1½ yards Red Snowflakes (F11943)

1 yard Red Winter Dots (C11944)

% yard Black Winter Dots (C11944) includes binding

1 Fat Eighth Red Stripes (F11942)

#### **CUTTING REQUIREMENTS**

Please read instructions before cutting fabrics. Refer to the quilt photo for the placement of fabrics. Label pieces as you cut.

#### From Assorted Hello Winter Prints cut:

3 squares 5" of each print. N

### From Multi Winter Dots cut:

6 strips 5" × WOF for 2nd Inner Border.

1 strip 16½" × WOF; subcut:

1 rectangle 16½" × 8½" B1 1 rectangle 16½" × 6½" B2 1 square 12½" × 12½" A 1 strip 2½" × 10½" B3

#### From Red Snowflakes cut:

7 strips 6½" × WOF for outer borders.

3 squares 5" N

#### From Red Winter Dots cut:

1 strip 8"  $\times$  WOF; subcut: 2 rectangles 8"  $\times$  12½" I 1 rectangle 6"  $\times$  16½" K

1 strip 6½" × WOF; subcut:

2 rectangles 6%" × 10" G 2 rectangles 6%" × 2%" H 1 rectangle 6" × 16%" K

1 strip 2½" × WOF; subcut:

2 strips 10" × 2½" J 4 squares 2½" E

1 strip 5" × WOF; subcut:

3 squares 5" N 4 squares 4½" F

2 strips 4½" × WOF; subcut:

1 strip 4½" × 27½" M 1 strip 3½" × 27½" L

#### From Black Winter Dots cut:

1 strip 6½" × WOF; subcut:

1 rectangle 6½" × 8½" D1 3 squares 5" N 1 strip 2½ × 15½" D2

7 strips 2½ × WOF for binding

# From Red Stripes cut:

1 strip 2½" × 21"; subcut:

1 strip 2½" × 8½" C1 1 strip 2½" × 6½" C2

3 squares 5" N


#### QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to the cutting requirements list, quilt photo and layout diagram for the placement of prints. Follow the pressing arrows in the diagrams as indicated.

# Stitch 'N Flip (SNF)

The Stitch 'N Flip technique is used to add a triangle of a contrasting fabric to any corner, "replacing" a corner of the original shape. **SNF** is used here to create the rounded effect of the snowman's head and body.


- 1. On the wrong side of 4 E squares, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner.
- 2. Position a drawn square right sides together onto 1 corner of the A square oriented as shown.
- 3. Stitch on the drawn line.
- 4. Cut away excess fabric leaving ¼" seam allowances.
- 5. Flip the triangle out and press.



6. Repeat Steps 2-5 to replace all 4 A corners to make the Snowman's Head.

# **Snowman Body**

- 1. Sew scarf piece C2 to body piece B3.
- 2. Sew **B1** and **B2** to the left and right sides of **C2B3** unit to make the snowman's body.
- 3. Using the **SNF** method (see previous section), replace all 4 corners of the Snowman's body using 4 F squares.




# **Snowman Center Assembly**

1. Sew the following pieces together side-to-side into rows:

Hat	G + D1 + G
Brim	H + D2 + H
Head	I + AE + I
Scarf	J + C1 + J
Body	K + BFC2 + K
	Brim Head Scarf

2. Sew rows 1-5 together. Sew strip  $\bf L$  to the top; strip  $\bf M$  to the bottom to complete the Snowman Center (27½" × 45½").



#### **Quilt Borders**

Refer to the Quilt Layout Diagram. Follow pressing arrows.

# First Inner Border

Gather all 42 **N** squares. Randomly choose squares to piece. There will be leftovers.

- 1. Sew 10 squares together into 1 strip 45½" long. Make 2. Sew 1 to each side of the Snowman Center.
- 2. Sew 8 squares together into 1 strip 36%" long. Make 2. Sew 1 to the top and 1 to the bottom of the Snowman Center (36%" × 54%").

#### Second Inner Border

- 1. Sew 3 Winter Multi 5" strips together into 1 long strip. From the strip cut 2 borders 54½" long. Sew 1 to each side of the quilt top.
- 2. Sew 3 Winter Multi 5" strips together into 1 long strip. From the strip cut 2 borders 45%" long. Sew 1 border to the top, the other to the bottom of the quilt (45%" × 63%").

# **Outer Border**

- 1. Sew 4 Red Snowflake 6%" strips together into 1 long strip. From the strip cut 2 borders 63%" long. Sew 1 to each side of the quilt top.
- 2. Sew 3 Red Snowflake 6%" strips together into 1 long strip. From the strip cut 2 borders 57%" long. Sew 1 to the top, the other to the bottom of the quilt. The quilt top now measures 57%" × 75%".

# **Finishing**

Finish the quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with 2½" Black Winter Dots strips.
