The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

7/8 yard Black Winter Dots (C11944) includes binding
1 Fat Eighth Red Stripes (F11942)

## CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions before cutting fabrics. Refer to the quilt photo for the placement of fabrics. Label pieces as you cut.

## From Assorted Hello Winter Prints cut: <br> 3 squares 5" of each print. N

## From Multi Winter Dots cut:

6 strips 5" $\times$ WOF for 2 nd Inner Border.

1 strip $16 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF; subcut:
1 rectangle $161 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \quad$ B1
1 rectangle $16 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \quad$ B2
1 square $12 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime} \quad A$
1 strip $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \quad$ B3

## From Red Snowflakes cut:

7 strips $612^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF for outer borders.

1 strip $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF; subcut:
2 rectangles $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime \prime} \quad G$
2 rectangles $61 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \quad H$
1 rectangle $6^{\prime \prime} \times 161 / 2^{\prime \prime} \quad$ K

2 strips $10^{\prime \prime} \times 2 ½$ J J

From Black Winter Dots cut:
1 strip $612^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF; subcut:
1 rectangle $612^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \quad$ D1
3 squares 5" N
1 strip $21 / 2 \times 15^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \quad$ D2

7 strips $21 / 2 \times$ WOF for binding

## From Red Stripes cut:

1 strip $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21^{\prime \prime}$; subcut:

## QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to the cutting requirements list, quilt photo and layout diagram for the placement of prints. Follow the pressing arrows in the diagrams as indicated.

## Stitch 'N Flip (SNF)

The Stitch ' N Flip technique is used to add a triangle of a contrasting fabric to any corner, "replacing" a corner of the original shape. SNF is used here to create the rounded effect of the snowman's head and body.

## Winter Friend

1. On the wrong side of 4 E squares, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner.
2. Position a drawn square right sides together onto 1 corner of the A square oriented as shown.
3. Stitch on the drawn line.
4. Cut away excess fabric leaving $1 / 4$ " seam allowances.
5. Flip the triangle out and press.

6. Repeat Steps 2-5 to replace all 4 A corners to make the Snowman's Head.

## Snowman Body

1. Sew scarf piece C2 to body piece B3.
2. Sew $B 1$ and $B 2$ to the left and right sides of $C 2 B 3$ unit to make the snowman's body.
3. Using the SNF method (see previous section), replace all 4 corners of the Snowman's body using 4 F squares.

## Snowman Center Assembly

1. Sew the following pieces together side-to-side into rows:

| Row 1 | Hat | G + D1 + G |
| :--- | :--- | :--- |
| Row 2 | Brim | $\mathrm{H}+\mathrm{D} 2+\mathrm{H}$ |
| Row 3 | Head | $\mathrm{I}+\mathrm{AE}+\mathrm{I}$ |
| Row 4 | Scarf | $\mathrm{J}+\mathrm{C} 1+\mathrm{J}$ |
| Row 5 | Body | $\mathrm{K}+\mathrm{BFC} 2+\mathrm{K}$ |

2. Sew rows 1-5 together. Sew strip $L$ to the top; strip $M$ to the bottom to complete the Snowman Center ( $271 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ $451 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ).


## Quilt Borders

Refer to the Quilt Layout Diagram. Follow pressing arrows.

## First Inner Border

Gather all 42 N squares. Randomly choose squares to piece.
There will be leftovers.

1. Sew 10 squares together into 1 strip $451 / 2$ " long. Make 2. Sew 1 to each side of the Snowman Center.
2. Sew 8 squares together into 1 strip $361 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ long. Make 2 . Sew 1 to the top and 1 to the bottom of the Snowman Center ( $361 / 21 \times 541 / 2$ ").

## Second Inner Border

1. Sew 3 Winter Multi 5 " strips together into 1 long strip. From the strip cut 2 borders $541 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ long. Sew 1 to each side of the quilt top.
2. Sew 3 Winter Multi 5 " strips together into 1 long strip. From the strip cut 2 borders $45 \frac{1}{2}$ " long. Sew 1 border to the top, the other to the bottom of the quilt ( $451 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} \times$ $631 / 2 ")$.

## Winter Friend

## Outer Border

1. Sew 4 Red Snowflake $61 / 2$ " strips together into 1 long strip. From the strip cut 2 borders $631 / 2$ " long. Sew 1 to each side of the quilt top.

Finishing
Finish the quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back.
Bind with 212 " Black Winter Dots strips.
Have fun and enjoy the journey of making your quilt!
2. Sew 3 Red Snowflake 612" strips together into 1 long strip. From the strip cut 2 borders $571 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ long. Sew 1 to the top, the other to the bottom of the quilt. The quilt top now measures $571 / 2 " \times 751 / 2 "$
