## Cutting Instructions

## Fabric 1:

- A - (16) $13 /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ " squares
- $\mathrm{B}-(4) 13 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
- $C-(4) 31 / 2 \prime$ squares
- $D-(4) 21 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ squares

Confetti Cotton Solids Materials by Riley blake Designs
Riley White (Fabric 1) Lipstick (Fabric 2) Rouge (Fabric 3)

Seafoam (Fabric 4)
Basil (Fabric 5)
HST = Half Square Triangle, SNF = Stitch and Flip

Fabrics 3, 4 and 5:

- Repeat Fabric 2 Cutting instructions with each of Fabrics 3, 4 and 5. Reference the labeled diagram to the left to label each cut piece. (Fabric $3=H$, I and J, Fabric $4=K, L$ and $M$, Fabric $5=N, O$ and $P$ )


## Sewing Instructions

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (4) C - squares. Place (3) C - squares aside for Step 3.

2. Place (1) C - square with (1) F - square, right sides together. Sew a $1 / 4$ " away from both sides of the drawn diagonal line. Cut along the drawn diagonal line, making (2) C/F HST units. Trim HST units to measure $3^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished.
3. Repeat HST unit assembly to make (2) C/I HST units, (2) C/L HST units and (2) C/O HST units.


Make (2) of each

4. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (8) $A$ - squares.
5. Place (1) A - square onto the color corner of each HST unit made in Steps 2-3, right sides together. Reference diagrams for A - square placement.
6. Sew along the drawn diagonal lines. Trim excess corner fabric to a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$. Press toward the corners.
7. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (4) D - squares.
8. Repeat HST unit assembly to make (2) D/G HST units, (2) D/J HST units, (2) D/M HST units and (2) D/P HST units. Trim HST units to measure $13 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 13 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished.
9. Arrange HST units made in Step 8 with assorted $13 / 4$ " squares to form the Block 11 center. Reference diagram for letter labels and placement of each square.


Make (2) of each

10. Sew the Block 11 center together. Arrows indicate pressing instructions. The Block 11 center should measure $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{1 / 2 \prime \prime}$ unfinished.
11. Sew together (1) A - square, (1) E - square and (1) B - rectangle as shown to form a corner unit measuring $3^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished.

12. Repeat to make (1) corner unit for each quadrant of the block using Fabrics 3, 4 and 5. Reference diagrams for letter labels.
13. Arrange the HST units with SNF corners, the Block 11 center and the corner units to form Block 11.

4. Sew the block together as shown. Arrows indicate pressing instructions. Once complete, Block 11 should measure $101 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished.
