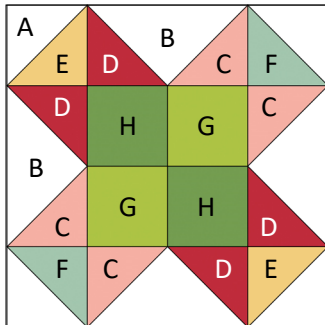

HST = HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE, SNF = STITCH AND FLIP



CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Fabric 1:

- A – (2) 3 1/2" squares
- B – (4) 3" x 5 1/2" rectangles

Fabric 2:

- C – (4) 3" squares

Fabric 3:

- D – (4) 3" squares

Fabric 4:

- E – (1) 3 1/2" square

Fabric 5:

- F – (1) 3 1/2" square

Fabric 6:

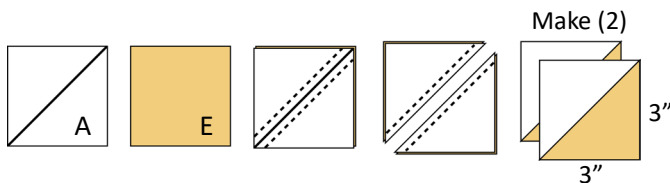
- G – (2) 3" squares

Fabric 7:

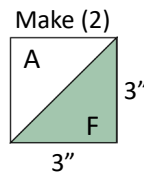
- H – (2) 3" squares

SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

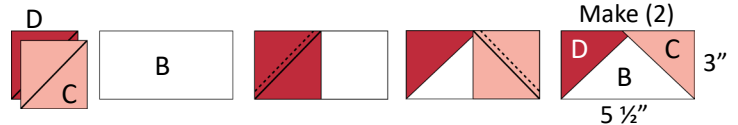
1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (2) A – squares. Set (1) A – square aside for Step 3.
2. Place (1) A – square with (1) E – square, right sides together. Sew a 1/4" away from both sides of the drawn diagonal line. Cut along the drawn diagonal line, making (2) A/E HST units. Trim HST units to 3" x 3" unfinished.



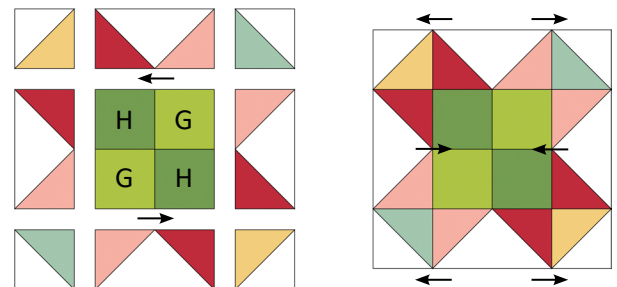
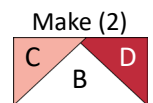
3. Repeat HST unit assembly to make (2) A/F HST units.



4. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (4) C – squares and (4) D – squares.
5. Place (1) D – square onto the top left corner of (2) B – rectangles, right sides together. Sew along the drawn diagonal lines. Trim excess corner fabric to a 1/4". Press toward the corners.
6. Repeat SNF techniques to attach (1) C – square to the top right corner of the same (2) B – rectangles to complete (2) flying geese units measuring 5 1/2" x 3" unfinished.

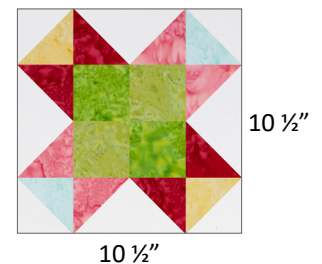


7. Repeat flying geese unit assembly to make (2) units with opposite fabric placement. Reference diagram to the right.



8. Arrange HST units, flying geese units, (2) G – squares and (2) H – squares to form Block 8 as shown above.

9. Sew the block together as shown. Press seams away from flying geese units. Once complete, Block 8 should measure 10 1/2" x 10 1/2" unfinished.
