Fabric 2:

- G - (6) 2" squares
- H-(1) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 91 / 2 \prime$ rectangle Fabric 3:
- $1-(3) 21 / 2 \prime$ squares
- J-(1) $1^{\prime \prime} \times 91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle


## Fabric 4:

- K - (2) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles

Fabric 5:

- $L-(2) 1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ r rectangles
- $M-(1) 2^{\prime \prime} \times 91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle
- N - (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle


## Sewing Instructions

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (3) $A$ - squares.
2. Place (3) A - squares with (3) I - squares, right sides together. Sew a $1 / 4$ " away from both sides of the drawn diagonal line on each set of squares. Cut along the drawn diagonal lines, making (6) A/I HST units. Trim HST units to $2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished.

3. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (6) G - squares. Set (3) G - squares aside for Step 5.
4. Place (1) $G$ - square onto the bottom left corner of (3) A/I HST units, right sides together. Reference diagrams for Gsquare placement. Sew along the drawn diagonal lines. Trim excess corner fabric to a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$. Press toward the corners. SNF units should measure $2^{\prime \prime} \times 2$ " unfinished.

5. Repeat SNF techniques to make (3) mirror image SNF units. The G - squares will be attached to the bottom right corner of the A/I HST units. Note the placement of HST unit colors.

6. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (10) B - squares.
7. Repeat SNF techniques to make an assortment of (3) different SNF units. Reference the diagrams for fabric pieces required, quantity to make, and measurement of each unit.

8. Arrange SNF units and the remaining cut pieces to form Block 4.
9. Sew the block together as shown. Press seams toward Fabric 1. Once complete, Block 4 should measure $101 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished.
