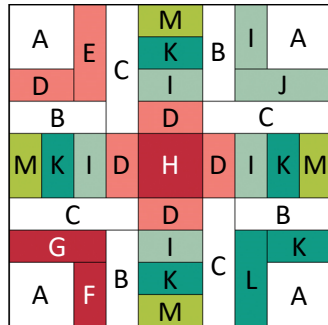

## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

### Fabric 1:

- A – (4) 2 ½" squares
- B – (4) 1 ½" x 3 ½" rectangles
- C – (4) 1 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles

### Fabric 2:

- D – (5) 1 ½" x 2 ½" rectangles\*
- E – (1) 1 ½" x 3 ½" rectangle

### Fabric 3:

- F – (1) 1 ½" x 2 ½" rectangle
- G – (1) 1 ½" x 3 ½" rectangle
- H – (1) 2 ½" square

### Fabric 4:

- I – (5) 1 ½" x 2 ½" rectangles\*
- J – (1) 1 ½" x 3 ½" rectangle

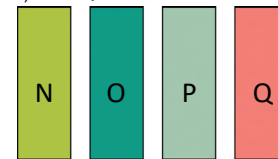
### Fabric 5:

- K – (5) 1 ½" x 2 ½" rectangles\*
- L – (1) 1 ½" x 3 ½" rectangle

### Fabric 6:

- M – (4) 1 ½" x 2 ½" rectangles\*

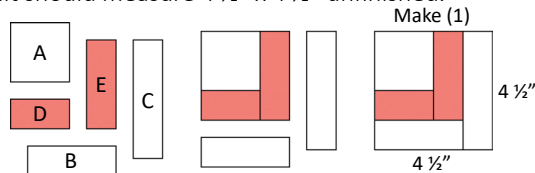
\*For Cindy's Strip Piecing option; cut (1) 1 ½" x 10 ½" rectangle in place of (4) 1 ½" x 2 ½" rectangles as shown and label them N, O, P, and Q.



N = Fabric 2  
O = Fabric 4  
P = Fabric 5  
Q = Fabric 6

## SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

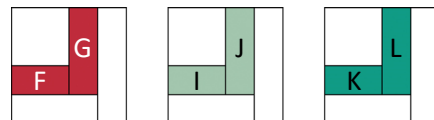
1. Arrange (1) A-square and rectangles from Fabrics 1 and 2 to form a corner unit. Reference the diagram for letter labels and the location of each cut piece.
2. Sew the corner unit together as shown, pressing outward after attaching each rectangle. Once complete, the corner unit should measure 4 ½" x 4 ½" unfinished.



3. Repeat to make (3) additional corner units with Fabrics 3, 4 and 5. Reference diagrams for letter labels and the location of each cut piece

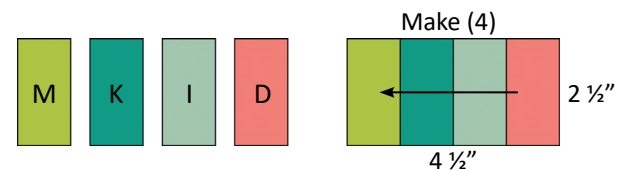
(location of A – squares, B – rectangles and C – rectangles remain the same).

### Make (1) of each

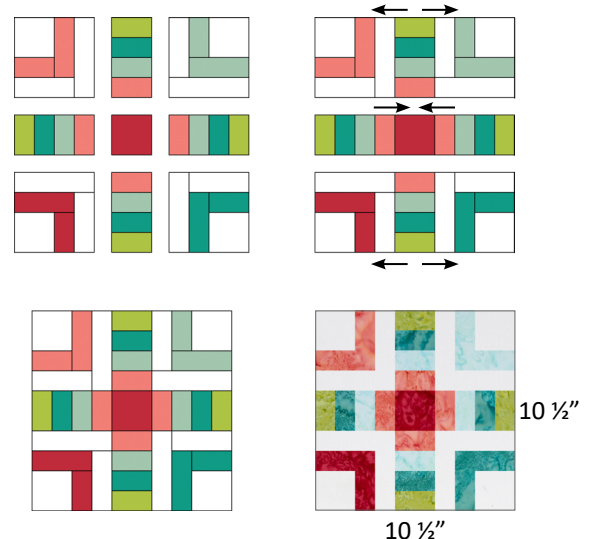


4. Arrange (1) D-rectangle, (1) I-rectangle, (1) K-rectangle and (1) M-rectangle to form a rectangle unit. (\*If using Cindy's Strip Piecing method, arrange the N, O, P, Q rectangles to make (1) large rectangle unit.)
5. Sew the rectangle unit together as shown, pressing seams toward the M-rectangle. The rectangle unit should measure 2 ½" x 4 ½" unfinished. (\*For Cindy's method, press toward the N-rectangle then subcut (4) 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles. Skip to step 7.)

6. Repeat to make a total of (4) identical rectangle units.



7. Arrange corner units, rectangle units and (1) H – square to form Block 16.
8. Sew the block together as shown. Arrows indicate pressing instructions. Once complete, Block 16 should measure 10 ½" x 10 ½" unfinished.
