EXPRESSIONS HAND-DYES MATERIALS BY RILEY BLAKE DESIGNS Snow White (Fabric 1) Light Teal (Fabric 2)

CONFETTI COTTON SOLIDS MATERIALS BY RILEY BLAKE DESIGNS Riley White (Fabric 1) Rain Forest (Fabric 2)

Additional Tools Needed: Basic Sewing Supplies, Backing: 3 % yards, 58" x 68" Piece of Batting

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Fabric 1:


- Cut (4) 10 ½" x WOF strips. Subcut the following in the order written to best utilize fabric:
 - o (3) 10 ½" x 30 ½" strips.
 - o (2) 10 ½" x 20 ½" strips.
 - o (1) 10 ½" square.


Fabric 2:


• Cut (6) 2 ¼" x WOF strips for binding.

FINAL QUILT ASSEMBLY

- 1. Arrange Blocks 1-16 as shown in the diagram. Place Fabric 1 strips and squares prepared during the Cutting Instructions as shown. Reference the diagram for the size and placement of each strip/square.
- 2. Sew the quilt top together in horizontal rows first. Alternate the direction in which you press the seams in each row.
- 3. Sew horizontal rows together, using pins to align and nestle seams. Press seams flat. Once complete, the quilt top should measure 50 %" x 60 %" unfinished.







FINISHING THE QUILT

- 1. Sandwich the backing, batting and quilt top. Baste layers together using your preferred method.
- 2. Quilt as desired.
- 3. Bind using (6) 2 ¼" x WOF Fabric 2 strips. Bind using your preferred method.
