## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Fabric 1:

- A - (8) $3^{\prime \prime}$ squares
- $B-(4) 3^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2 \prime$ rectangles


## Fabric 2:

- C - (1) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 14^{\prime \prime}$ strip

Fabric 3:

- $D-(1) 1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 14^{\prime \prime}$ strip

HST = Half Square Triangle, sNF = Stitch and Flip

## Fabric 4:

- E - (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime} \times 14^{\prime \prime}$ strip

Fabric 5:

- F - (1) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 14^{\prime \prime}$ strip

Fabric 6:

- G - (1) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 14^{\prime \prime}$ strip


## Sewing Instructions

1. Referencing the diagram, sew strips labeled C-G together lengthwise. Use the following fabric order. Press seams in one direction. Strip set should measure $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 14^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished.
a. $F+C+D+E+G$


2. Subcut (4) $3^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ units from the strip set.
3. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (8) A squares.

4. Place (1) A - square onto the top left corner of each subcut unit, right sides together. Note the orientation of the drawn diagonal line on the wrong side of the A - square in the diagram.
5. Sew along the drawn diagonal lines on each square/unit combination. Trim excess corner fabric to a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$. Press toward the corners.
6. Repeat SNF techniques to attach (1) A - square to the top right corner of each subcut unit to complete (4) flying geese units measuring $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished.

7. Arrange flying geese units with (4) $B$ - rectangles to form Block 14.
8. Sew the block together as shown. Press seams toward the B - rectangles. Arrows indicate additional pressing instructions. Once complete, Block 14 should measure 10 12" x 10 12" unfinished.
