Following the Great Depression and the Second World War, the International Monetary Fund (IMF) and World Bank were established (at Bretton Woods) to stabilize and encourage economic growth. With the addition of trade agreements and now the World Trade Organization, the three economic institutions aim for a prosperous, just and sustainable world economy that obviously depends upon a healthy global environment. However recent disjoint responses to the climate emergency and the COVID-19 pandemic highlight the need for fundamental reform of these economic institutions.
