



Directions

Watering Can

Add 1 tsp per quart (32 oz) of water.

Spring & Summer

Apply every 1-2 weeks.

Fall & Winter

Apply every 4 weeks.

Leaf Misting (Optional)

Add 1/2 tsp per pint (16 oz) of water.
Spray on leaves. Apply every 1-2 weeks.

Grow Tip

These plants are hard to flower indoors and can take 4+ years to bloom, lots of light and higher temps can help them bloom.

Growing Recommendations



Soil

Try a loamy, well-draining soil with some water retention.



Watering

Moderate to heavy waterings, allow soil to mostly dry between waterings.



Lighting

Generally, bird of paradise prefer direct, moderate to bright light.
