With 1 in 100 babies born with a congenital heart defect (CHD) globally each year, we have the ability to impact a child's life and provide a lifetime of freedom from this disease.

In industrialized countries such as the United States, the corrective surgery is accessible and provided to those in need, regardless of financial capacity or geographic location. In 2000, HeartGift was founded to address this disparity and since its inception, it has served more than 800 children from 35 countries, with chapters in Austin, San Antonio, New Orleans and Houston.


