## MEET TRIGG

When Trigg was born he immediately turned blue and struggled to breathe on his own. After hugs and kisses, our baby was rushed off to NICU for tests. We eventually discovered Trigg was born with a rare condition called Hypoplastic right heart syndrome with tricuspid atresia and pulmonary artresia. Basically, Trigg was born with half a heart with pulmonary concerns. At 2 weeks old, Trigg received his 1st surgery followed by his 2nd surgery at 5 months. To address Trigg's pulmonary arteries being so small, he had an unplanned open heart surgery just a few months ago. The last palliative surgery will hopefully take place in the next few years.

We don't know what the future holds for Trigg but are encouraged by his strength and attitude he puts on every day. He wrestles with his older brothers, is now walking, loves to take baths, plays catch with anyone willing, and enjoys a good snuggle when he watches tv. We are blessed to have a great support system for our family and outstanding group of doctors that monitor Trigg's health closely.
