## Sanitising Fumigator INSTRUCTION MANUAL

## **Get To Know Your Fogger**

- 1. Solution Tank: This is where you pour the sanitiser solution.
- 2. On/Off Switch: Turns the fogger on and off
- 3. Droplet Size Adjuster: Adjusts the fog mist size
- 4. Nozzle: Fog is discharged here
- 5. Air Inlet: Air is drawn into the unit here.



## SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

- 1. Read the full instruction manual before attempting to use the fogger.
- 2. Always read the labels & SDS for fogging chemicals before use.
- **3.** Fogging involves contact with chemicals. Wear appropriate personal protection equipment when fogging which includes the following as a minimum; Carbon filter mask, gloves, long sleeve cotton shirt, eye protection.
- 4. The fogger will discharge solution approximately 6m. Plan your application prior to attempting to fog.
- 5. Do not discharge fogger next to open flame.



## **Operation Instructions**

- Fill the solution tank with sanitiser solution, taking care not to overfill. Note: if you are new to fogging consider use with water only to start with until the units operation is understood.
- 2. Plug in the cord to a power outlet.
- 3. Direct the fogger in the region you wish to fog
- 4. Turn the Fogger on
- 5. Adjust the droplet size to achieve the desired application rate.
- **6.** Apply sanitiser to area with fogger as needed and turn off when application has concluded.

**Note:** Fogging is most effective in low wind conditions as the fog will hang for longer. If low wind is present, ensure you work with the wind on your back to limit exposure to the fogging chemicals.
