Unlike Bees wax Japwax Puttysticks maybe lacquered over without sinkage or shrinkage of the coating being applied, also Japwax puttysticks is more durable due to having a much higher tensile strength and melting point, giving a superior finish;

It may be used on timber surfaces, Formica or Laminex whether it is furniture or fixture.

Japwax Puttysticks are available in two sizes, either hand use or hot melt gun. We have a range of thirteen colours and the sticks are packed in lots of five or seven of the same colour.

Application

With hand application, it is applied by rubbing the stick over the damaged area.

In the case of large cavities it can be used by heating a knife blade with a cigarette lighter soldering iron or flame and applied hot to the bruised area.

With the hot melt size sticks place the stick in a No Beeswax means the product will clean purpose use hot melt gun, allow the gun to readily accept coatings. heat up do not force the stick, let the gun do the work.

Any excess may be removed by rubbing with the smooth side of the sandpaper or cardboard.
