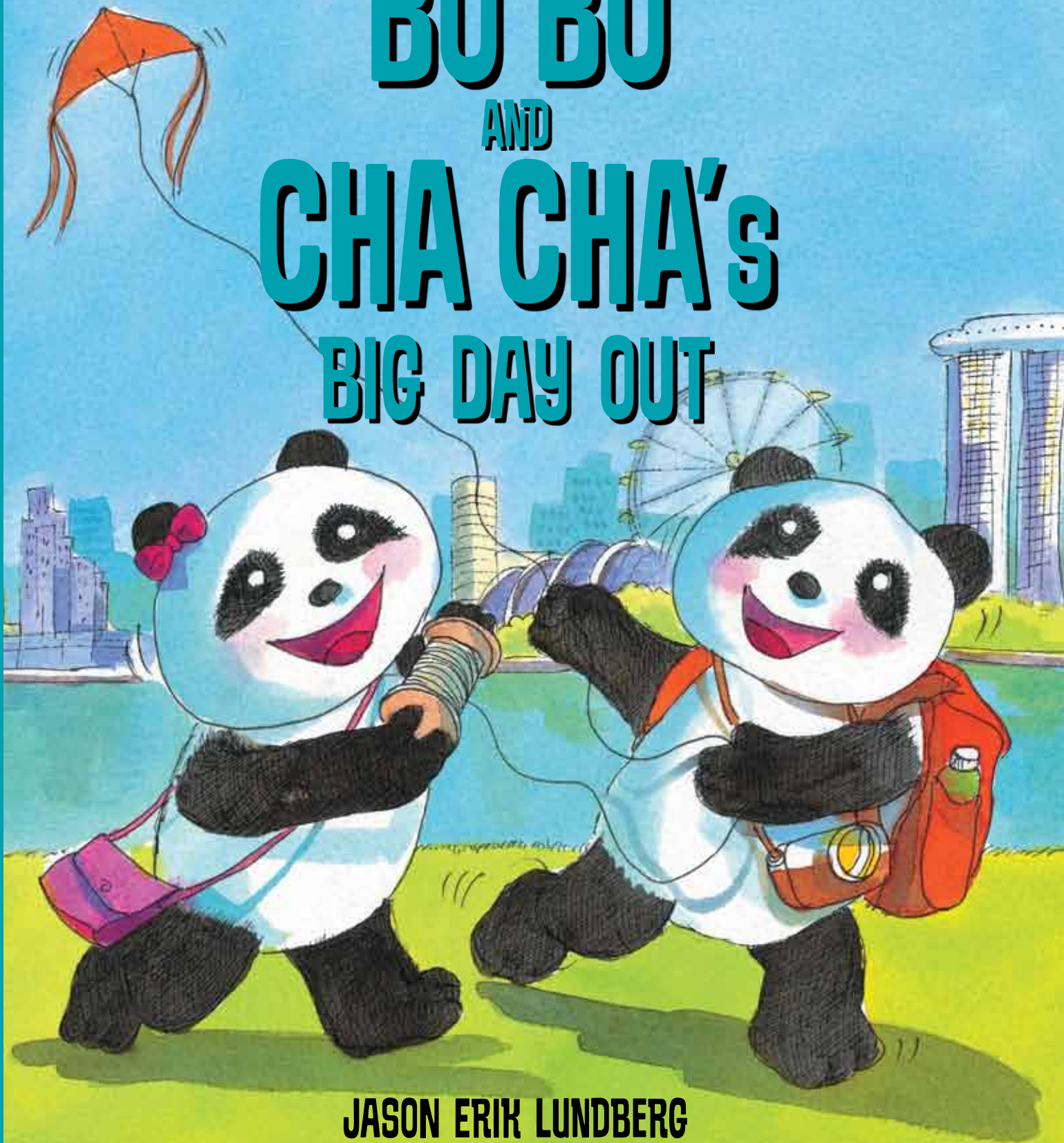

Bo Bo looks through his bag for everything they will need. "Water bottle, check," he says. "Snacks, umbrella, city map: check and double-confirm!"



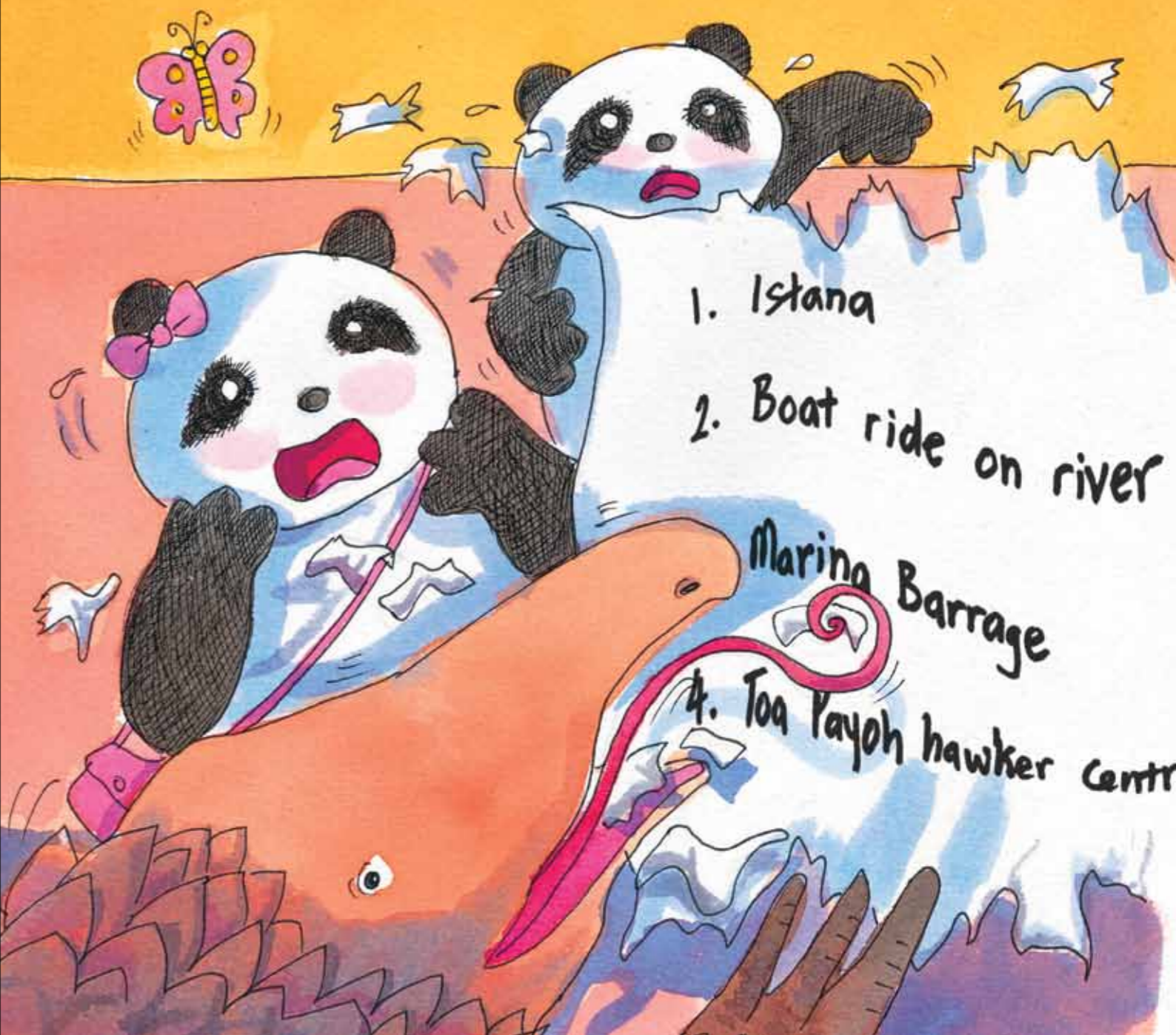
Cha Cha looks over their list of sights to see. It's quite long!

“Hey! Why did you do that?” Bo Bo yells. “It took a long time to write those down!”

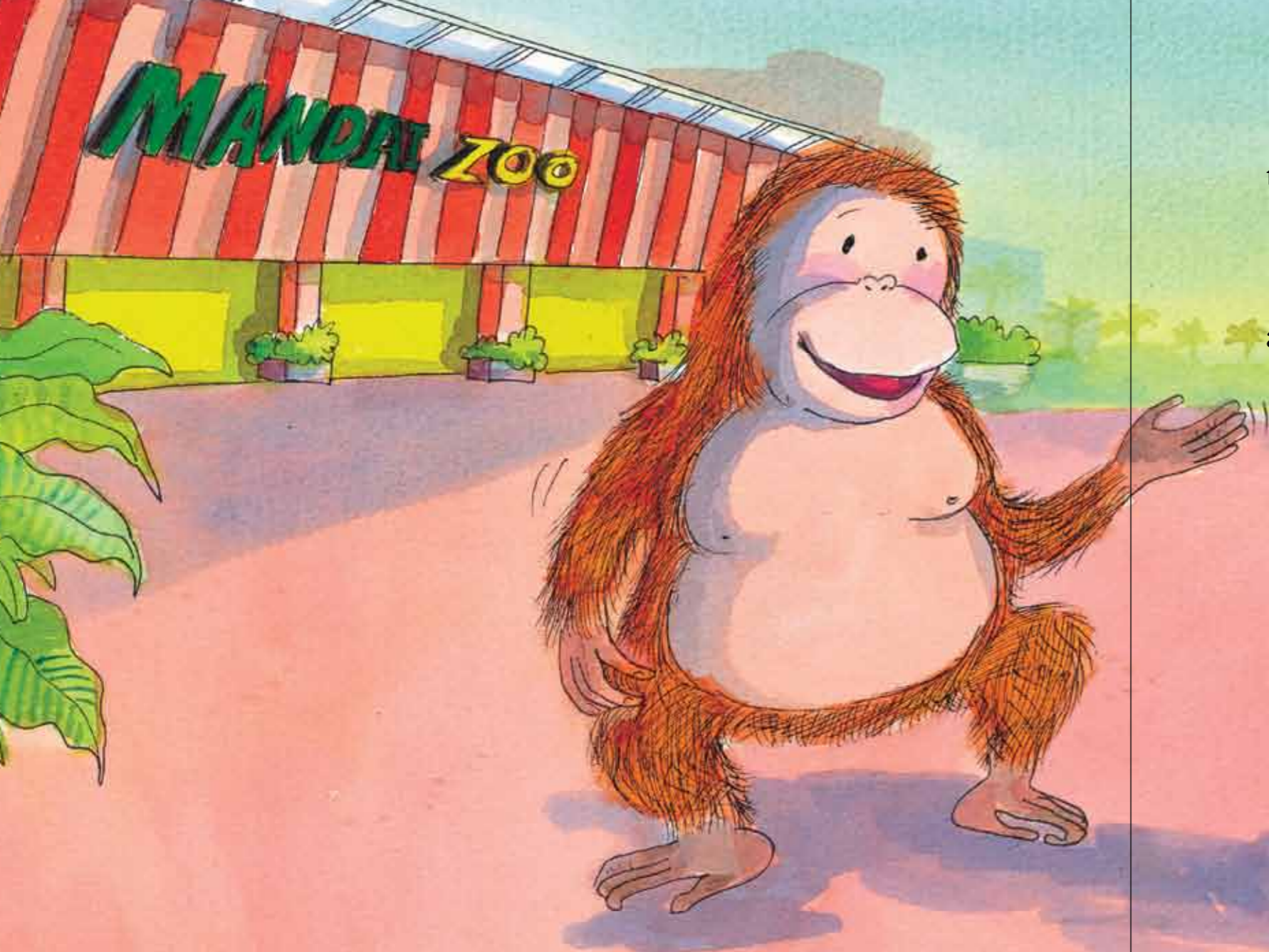
“I’m sorry,” says Perang. “I was only trying to help.”

The hawker food there is so *shiok*."


"It's on our list!" Bo Bo says.
