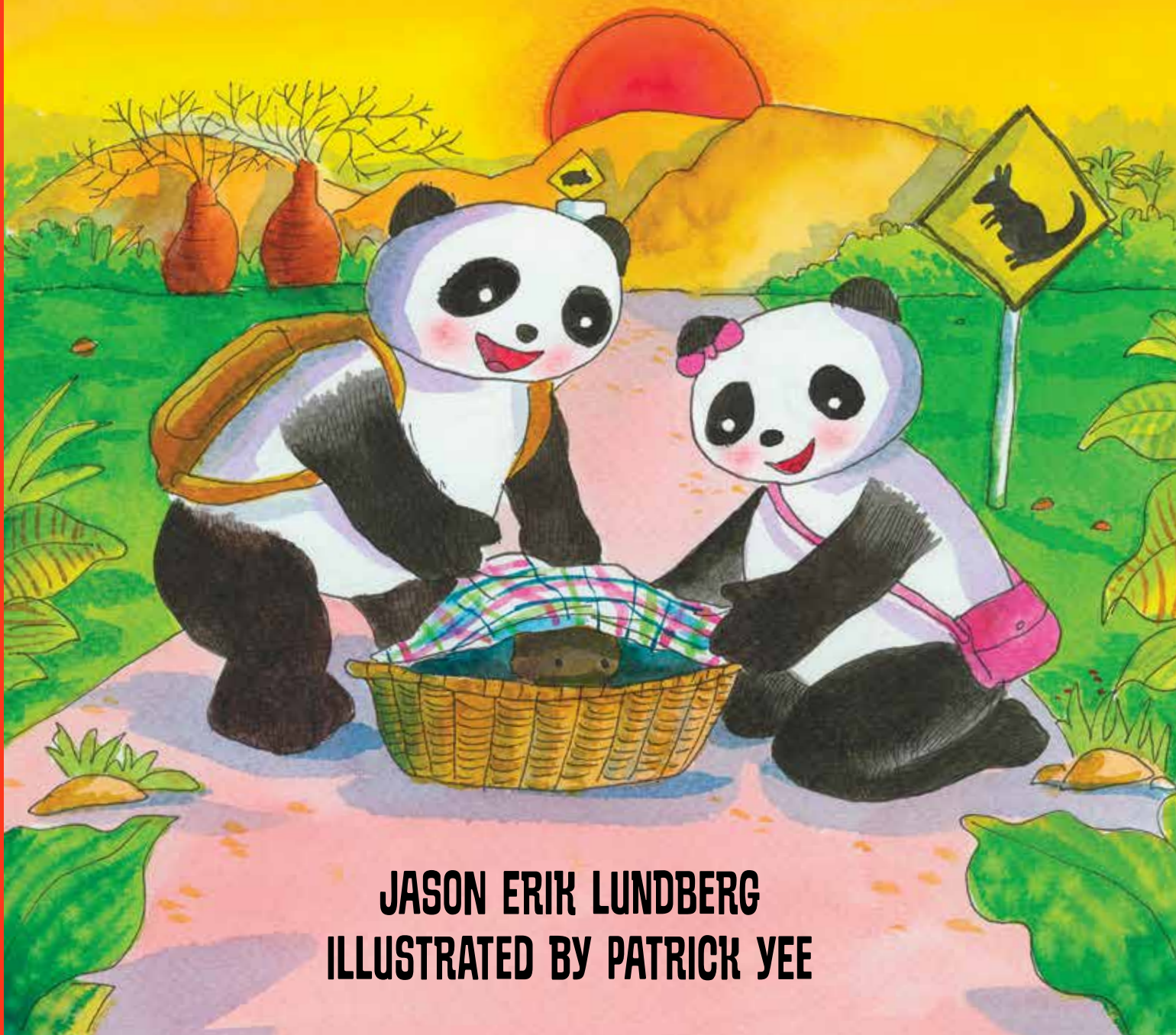

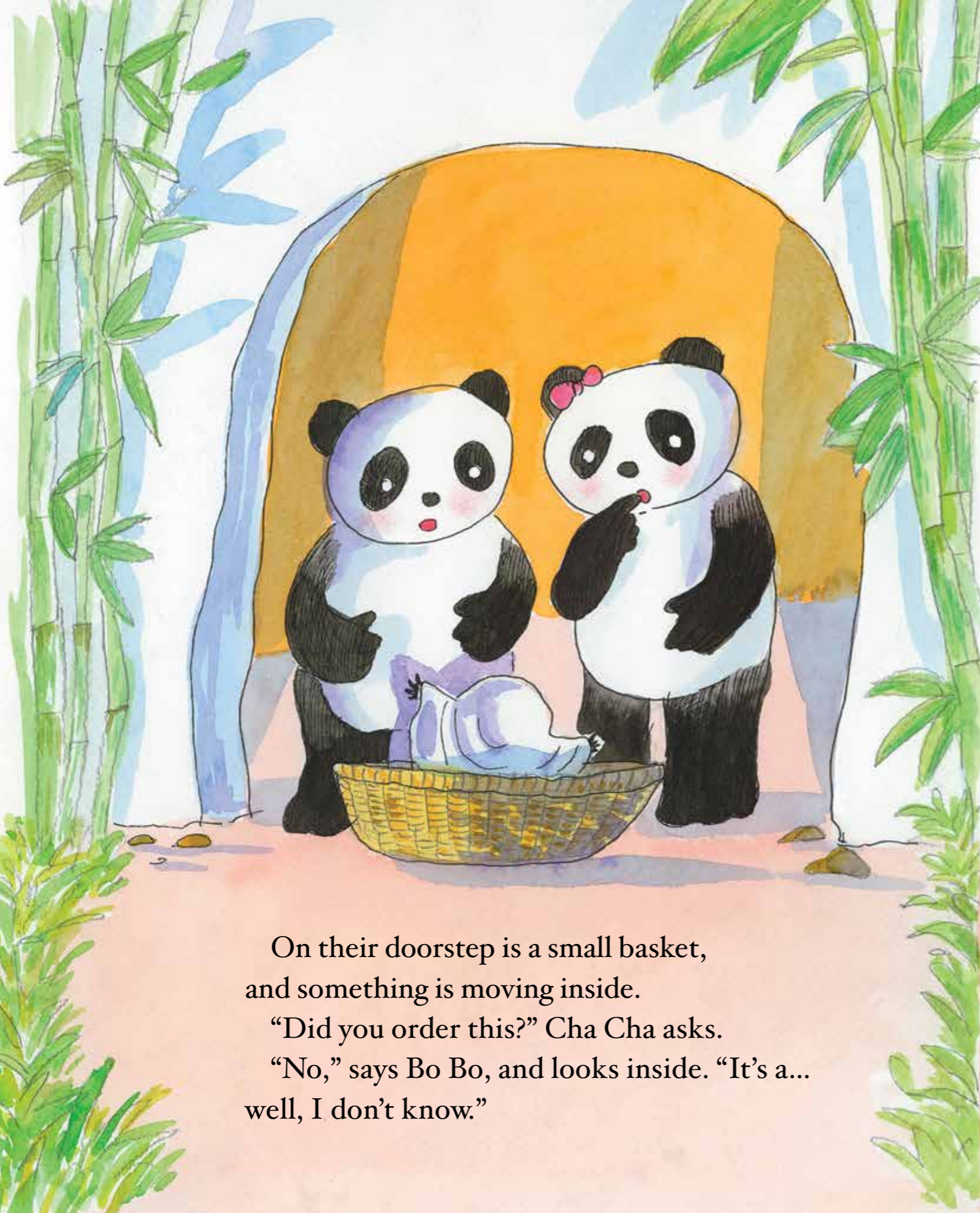

well, I don’t know.”

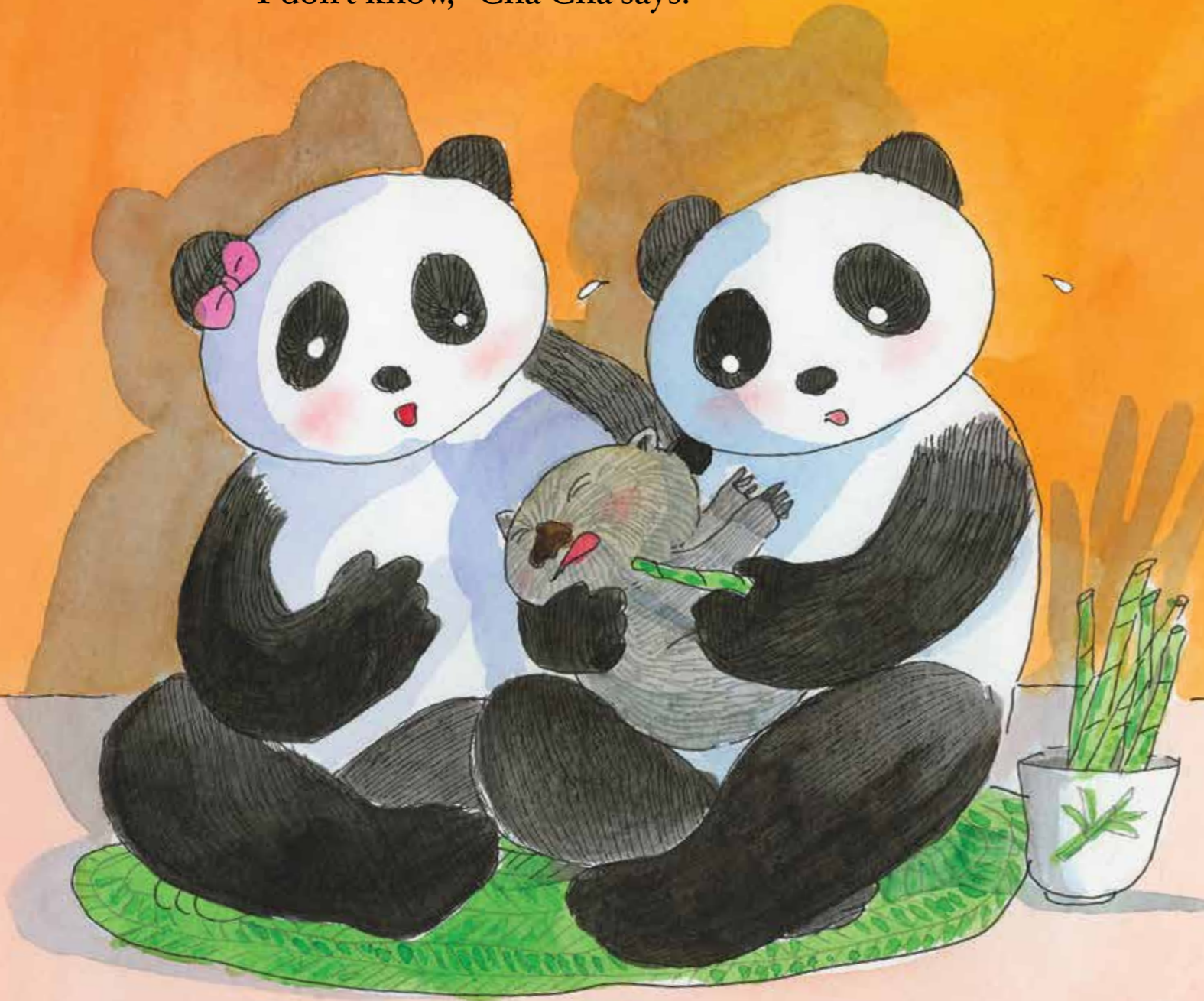
“Oh! Isn’t she cute!” Cha Cha says. “I wonder

The baby crawls down to the rug, sniffs it, then takes a bite.

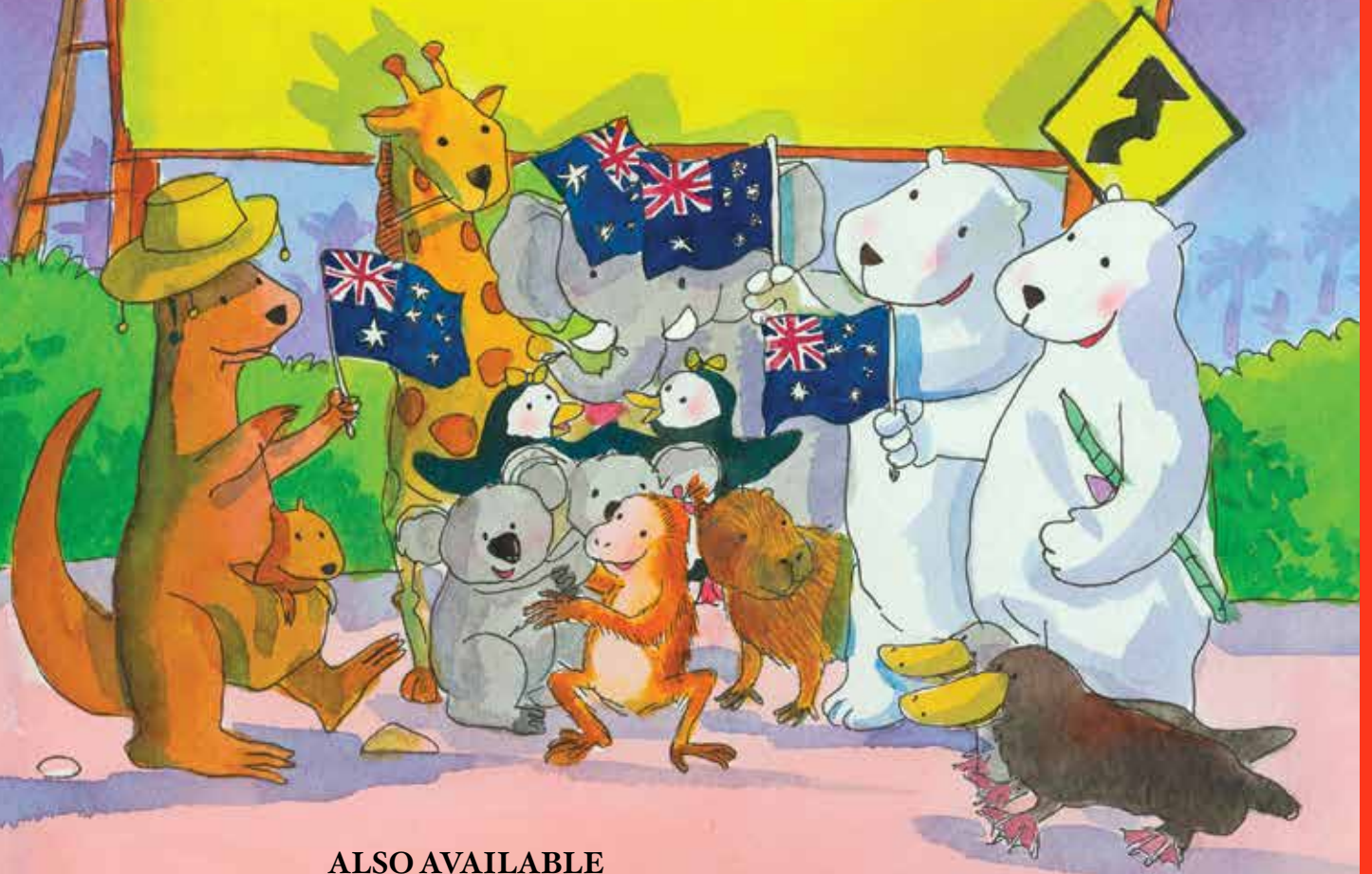
“Grass!” the pandas say. “She likes grass!”
