





There, 16 guys and 16 girls sat around tables and socialised.



Two guys talked with two girls for each round of 10 minutes. So basically, I had five minutes to chat with each girl.








These events were great ways to work on conversational skills (for those who even had any in the first place!) with the opposite sex.





five people they wanted to get to know better. The organiser would only give contact details to the lucky people whose choices had also chosen them.






















Dear Date King,






