



Ring Sizing Guide


To achieve the most accurate result always have your ring size measured at one of our Authorized Retail Partners. This guide will only give you an approximate size and results may be different from a professional jeweler. **Please read the following carefully.**

- 1. Before printing this ring sizing guide, please ensure that the PDF is printing at 100% scale by unchecking "Scale to Fit" on your printer settings.
- 2. Measure the line on the right to ensure it is exactly 2 inches.
- ** Tip: If the ruler does not match, check your printer settings and try again.




Paper Sizer

- 1. Carefully cut out the paper sizer below. Make a small cut along the line labeled "Cut Slit Here".
- 2. Gently wrap the sizer around your finger and slide the thin end through the slit. Make sure the numbers are facing out.
- 3. For an accurate measurement, pull the sizer tight over the widest part of your finger. Make sure the sizer will still fit over your knuckle.
- 4. Read the number that lines up next to the slit. This is your ring size.



Measure an Existing Ring

- 1. Choose a ring that you wear on the same finger as the Kirk Kara ring you are currently interested in.
- 2. Position the ring over the circles below. Match the inside edge of the ring with the closest circle.
- ** Tip: If the ring falls between two sizes, select the larger of the two.
- K Tip: If you are ordering a wide band select a larger size or measure a ring with a similar width.
- **Tip: Make sure the entire black circle is visible inside of the ring. If a portion is covered, try going a half size down. If there is too much white space, go a half size up.
