As a practicing, board certified Urologist for 18 years, it is my pleasure to provide a testimonial about the Endoluxe system. I have been lucky enough to use the Endoluxe system in my office and surgical center for cystoscopic surgeries. These include diagnostic cystoscopies, bladder tumor resections, cystoscopic botox injections and treatment of urinary obstruction.
